



I. INTRODUCTION

The sample data from the Household Facilities and Equipment surveys are weighted up to estimates of total households derived from the Censuses of Canada. The projections of total households used for weighting the surveys from 1967 to 1971 were taken from the 1966 Census, while the projections of total households used for weighting the 1972 and subsequent surveys were based on the 1971 Census counts.

To provide greater comparability and with the availability of 1971 Census information, revised estimates for all tables published during the years 1967-1971 have been produced. The revised estimates for all tables and for all five years are attached.

For more information concerning the definitions of the terms used in this bulletin, the coverage of the survey as well as the reliability of estimates, see Household Facilities and Equipment (Cat. 64-202).



I. INTRODUCTION

Les données fragmentaires des enquêtes sur l'équipement ménager sont pondérées en fonction des estimations du nombre total de ménages déduites des recensements du Canada. Les projections du nombre total de ménages qui ont servi à pondérer les enquêtes de 1967 à 1971 prenaient comme point de départ le recensement de 1966, alors que les projections du nombre total de ménages utilisées pour pondérer les résultats des enquêtes à partir de 1972 étaient fondées sur le recensement de 1971.

Pour assurer une meilleure comparabilité et avec l'accessibilité des données du recensement de 1971, des estimations rectifiées ont été produites pour l'ensemble des tableaux publiés entre 1967 et 1971. Les estimations rectifiées pour l'ensemble des tableaux et l'ensemble des cinq années sont présentées dans cette brochure.

Pour de plus amples renseignements concernant les définitions des termes utilisés ici, le champ de l'enquête de même que la fiabilité des estimations, on voudra bien se rapporter à L'Équipement Ménager (64-202 au catalogue).




























































