

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PRELIMINARY REPORT ON THE CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1944.

(Census of Construction figures refer to "on site" operations only and do not include statistics of the manufacture of building materials.)

A preliminary report of Construction operations performed by GENERAL, TRADE and SUBCONTRACTORS during the year 1944 and containing all completed reports received in this office as at the 31st of May 1945, is presented herewith.

Completed reports received by the end of May totalled 14,102 which represents an increase of 3,047 from the number received during the same period of last year. A considerable number of reports were received from owner-builders and amounts have been included in all tables. However, although these increase the number of reports received, the comparatively small extent of their operations does not appreciably affect other totals. The value of work reported amounted to \$308,678,325, \$198,729,530 of which represented new construction, while the remaining \$109,948,795 referred to additions, alterations and repairs. Corresponding figures for 1943 were \$434,060,036, \$345,042,448 and \$89,017,588.

The cost of materials used was \$143,230,401 in 1944 and \$219,728,230 in 1943.

The average number of wage-earners reported in 1944 totalled 57,202 compared with 84,602 in 1943, and wages paid for the respective years were \$96,611,671 and \$148,317,962. Salaried employees in 1944 were reported as 18,870 and earnings \$30,962,653 in comparison with 17,700 and salaries of \$31,533,200 in 1943. Total of employees reported in 1944 was 76,072 with salaries and wages amounting to \$127,574,324, while the respective figures for 1943 were 102,303 employees and \$179,851,162 salaries and wages.

Due to the varying numbers of returns received by May 31st each year, it is difficult to estimate final figures on the basis of returns already received. Table 2, therefore, gives only a comparison of the preliminary and final figures for 1943, together with the percentages of the preliminary to the final figures. No final estimate of the work performed by the general, trade and subcontractors is given for 1944.

Table 3 of the report contains a detailed description, classification and value of work performed during 1943 and 1944 by all General, Trade and Subcontractors. Table 4 is similar, but contains work performed by Subcontractors only.

Table 5 shows the average monthly employment of wage-earners by provinces for the two years, together with the amount of wages paid in each province.

The remaining tables of the report are devoted to provincial statistics, that is, the classification and value of work by all groups is shown for each province in detail.
