## INTRODUCTION.

The materials for this table were collected during the autumn of 1884.

The distribution of schedules was made through the Post Office Inspectors 3,516 Postmasters. We afterwards took some pains to ascertain that all received them.

They were sent in numbers sufficient to supply every farmer cultivating ten acres and upwards.

In addition to the schedules, every Postmaster was supplied with an envelope directed to the department and another, in which to place the one so directed, and the schedule for every farmer receiving his mail through that Office.

It is to be regretted that out of 150,000 delivered, only 78,786 were returned to this department: on the other hand, those that were returned were generally very well filled up and appeared to give a true and faithful return of stock, crops, etc., as well as of the averages in Grain and Root crops. This fact is well confirmed by the averages per acre deduced therefrom.

If this experiment in the collection of Agricultural Statistics through the Postmasters has so far proved a partial failure as to giving the quantities produced, at least it has given a fair indication of the averages per acre.

Some people may think these averages a little too high, but it should be remembered that it is usually the best and most intelligent of the farmers who respond to these appeals. They know well that there was no ulterior motive, other than to assist in the science of Government, that a return of their productions was solicited.

## INTRODUCTION.

La matière contenue dans ce rapport a été recueillie durant l'automne de 1884.

La distribution des tableaux aux cultivateurs s'est faite par l'entremise des inspecteurs des postes, à 3,516 maîtres de poste. On a pris ensuite la peine de s'assurer que chaque maître de poste avait reçu ces tableaux en quantité suffisante pour que tout cultivateur occupant dix acres de terre et plus en reçût un.

Chacun de ces tableaux était accompagné de deux enveloppes; l'une portant l'adresse de ce département et dans laquelle devait nous être renvoyé le tableau rempli; l'autre sur laquelle le maître de poste devait écrire l'adresse du cultivateur et y inclure le tableau à être rempli et l'enveloppe partant l'adresse de ce département.

Il est regrettable que sur 150,000 tableaux ainsi distribués, nous n'en ayons reçu que 78,786. Les tableaux, cependant, qui nous ont été expédiés, ont été remplis d'une manière très satisfaisante, et semblent donner un rapport vrai du stock, de la récolte, etc., de même pour les grains et les racines, tel que démontré d'ailleurs par les moyennes par acre.

Si ce premier essai pour recueillir les statistiques agricoles n'a pas eu un succès complet, quant à la quantité des produits, il nous a, au moins, donné une bonne indication des moyennes par acre.

Quelques personnes trouveront peut-être les chiffres de ces moyennes un peu élevés, mais elles devront se rappeler que la plupart des cultivateurs qui répondent à ces appels, sont généralement les plus indépendants de fortune et les plus intelligents parmi cette classe d'hommes.

There were many, no doubt, whose neglect to respond arose from absence of the head of the family at the moment, and neglect followed.

There were also many, no doubt, who failed to respond through apathy or want of interest. There were also, it may be presumed, some who thought themselves wiser than their neighbours and declined to respond, thinking that possibly it might mean taxation, and there were others who would not respond because they had no sympathy with the political party then in power. There were others, it may be supposed, who were perfectly willing and desirous of doing all that was right and proper, but put it off till the "proverbial to-morrow."

Enfin, un très grand nombre avaient sans doute l'intention de remplir ces tableaux, mais, malheureusement, ils en sont restés là : remettant toujours la tâche à l'éternel demain.
