
PEST MANAGEMENT CENTRE

Partnering for Results

Agriculture and Agri-Food Canada's (AAFC) Pest Management Centre (PMC) achieves its mission by fostering partnerships and working together with key stakeholders and partners through its Minor Use Pesticides and Pesticide Risk Reduction teams.



The Minor Use Pesticides team works with grower organizations and provinces to identify crop/pest priorities, and partners with Health Canada's Pest Management Regulatory Agency, the United States Department of Agriculture IR-4 Project, registrant companies, and researchers to develop data necessary to meet regulatory requirements for the registration of new minor uses of pesticides.

The **Pesticide Risk Reduction team** works with grower organizations, AAFC's researchers, academia, the provinces, industry and other federal departments to develop pesticide risk reduction strategies addressing priority pest issues. Strategy adoption is facilitated through projects to develop and demonstrate sustainable reduced risk pest management tools and practices including Integrated Pest Management (IPM) systems.
