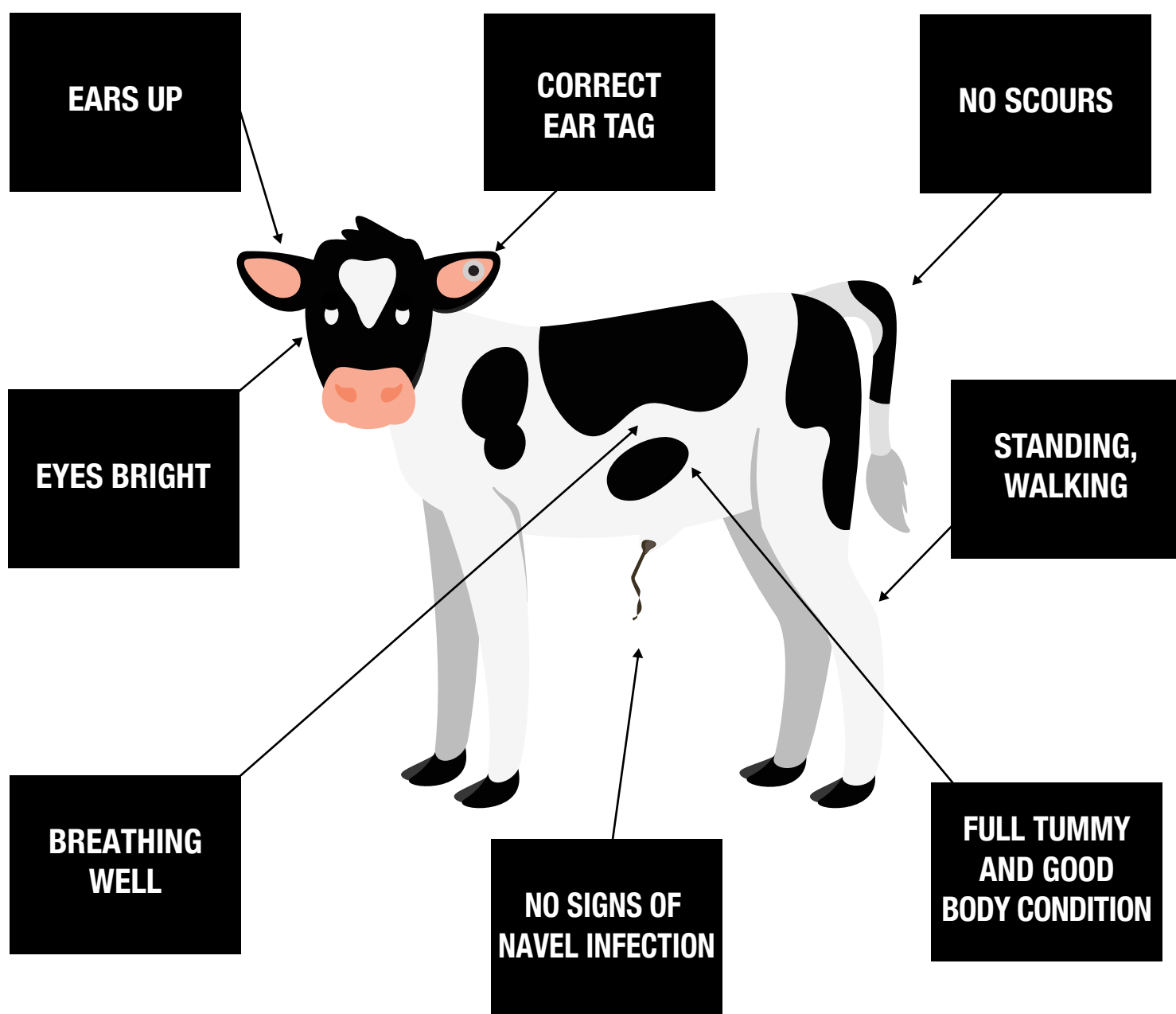


# MAKE SURE YOUR CALF IS FIT FOR TRANSPORT



## CHECK THESE 8 BEFORE YOU LEAVE THE GATE



### NOTE

- Calves can remain without access to feed, water and rest for a maximum of 12 hours, during which any risk of nutritional deficit, dehydration or exhaustion must be prevented.
- There can be a maximum of 12 hours between the beginning of their loading and the end of their unloading.
- Calves 8 days of age or less can only be transported once and cannot go to an assembly centre.
