#### CWS COASTAL SURVEY BLOCKS IN ATLANTIC CANADA

#### I. Background

In 1967, Allan D. (Al) Smith and W. R. (Bill) Whitman at the New Brunswick field office of the Canadian Wildlife Service, initiated the Coastal Waterfowl Surveys Program in the Maritime Provinces. In order to ensure that the data collected would serve to establish long-term trends in waterfowl populations, they created permanent survey blocks along the coastline of the three maritime provinces that could be used repeatedly by many observers over many years. In 1975, Tony Lock standardized the blocks in all three provinces and, in 1981, assigned survey blocks to Newfoundland. Blocks for Labrador were designed by Tony in 1991 and first flown by Scott Gilliland in 1993 and finalized in 1994.

These survey blocks were based on recognizable coastal features (headlands, rivers and islands) easily visible and recognizable from the air and marked on a 1: 250,000 topographic map to facilitate data recording by observer(s) in a small aircraft. Instead of noting every community on a map and/or marking the latitudes/longitudes to mark the location where birds were sighted, all birds seen within these topographic "markers" were simply assigned a specific block number which was marked in large/bold numbers on a map. In Smith and Whitman's first descriptions, the survey block numbers ranged from block 1 in New Brunswick (Grand Manan) to block number 864 in Newfoundland (Port aux Basques). Once the survey blocks were decided upon in Newfoundland and Labrador, the block numbers extended to number 1045 in Cape Chidley, Labrador. Observers could therefore concentrate their attention on surveying numbers and species of waterbirds within the blocks.

In order to make available all the aerial survey data which had been already accumulated by the CWS prior to 1967, Tony Lock summarized all the coastal aerial surveys in the maritime provinces going back to 1955 (Al Smith, pers. comm.). Hence, all aerial survey data on species composition and numbers of coastal waterfowl dating back to 1955 and recorded by survey block are available at the CWS office in Sackville, N.B.

Prior to the preparation of this report, the locations of these blocks were only available on the original maps on which they were copied and distributed to the provincial wildlife divisions in New Brunswick, Nova Scotia and Prince Edward Island. Using these maps, all the waterfowl data collected along the provinces' coastlines by aerial surveys could be easily summarized and interchanged between the federal and provincial governments. With few exceptions, where the locations

of some survey blocks in Atlantic Canada are shown (see: A.R. Lock, R.G.B. Brown and S.H. Gerriots. 1994. Gazetteer of Marine Birds in Atlantic Canada) no other document is available to show the locations of all the survey blocks in Atlantic Canada.


In order to make these survey block locations useful and easily available, this report was prepared such that it can be easily reproduced and distributed. Members of the general public can readily obtain copies; consequently, those interested individuals can more easily understand many government reports which discuss the results of these surveys using survey block numbers. And furthermore, any observers, such as university students or consulting firms, undertaking coastal surveys can use these maps and record the numbers of birds seen by block number to compare with aerial surveys dating back to 1955.


#### II. Coverage


For the purpose of conducting aerial surveys of coastal birds, the coastline of Atlantic Canada is represented by 621 survey blocks which amount to 24,257 km. In the Maritime Provinces, 310 survey blocks represent 11,914 km of coastline; of this total, 26.0% (3,098 km; 67 blocks) is in New Brunswick, 58.9% (7,007 km; 212 blocks) in Nova Scotia and 15.2% (1,809 km; 31 blocks) in Prince Edward Island. And the total area surveyed in Newfoundland amounts to 12,343 km of coastline which represents 52.8% of the coast of the Atlantic Provinces which is represented by 311 survey blocks. Although the locations of survey blocks in Newfoundland and Labrador are shown on maps, the boundary descriptions are not included in Appendix I. Two blocks in Chaleur Bay (numbers 365 and 366) are in Quebec.


#### III. Format


The information in this report is presented in two very different formats which essentially give the reader the same information but differ in objectives and amount of detail: maps and an appendix. The maps (Figures 1 to 16) give a visual representation of where each block is located in the region (including Newfoundland and Labrador) while the appendix lists all the locations with details as to the boundaries between the blocks in the maritimes (appendix I) but not for Newfoundland and Labrador. Because of the large number of blocks in Newfoundland and Labrador, these detailed descriptions will be made available in a separate appendix at a later time. All the boundaries used to create the survey blocks described in this report are intended to be easily recognizable from the air. The maps in this report were prepared using the software **MapInfo**.



















FIGURE 7 COASTAL SURVEY BLOCKS: PRINCE EDWARD ISLAND -NORTHUMBERLAND STRAIT AREA N.B. 308 307 N.S.











