

International students accounted for all of the growth in postsecondary enrolments in 2018/2019

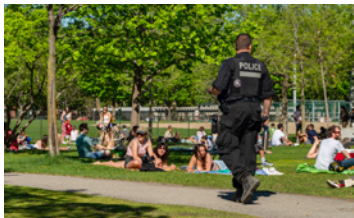
Over 2.1 million students were enrolled in Canadian public universities and colleges in 2018/2019, up 1.8% from the previous year. This was attributable to a 16.2% increase (+47,952) in international student enrolments, while enrolments by Canadian students edged down 0.5% (-8,301).

Most Canadians report confidence in police

Just over 4 in 10 Canadians aged 15 and older in the provinces reported having a great deal of confidence in the police in 2019, while nearly half said they had some confidence. Just under 1 in 10 Canadians reported having low confidence in police—that is, not very much or no confidence at all.

Seniors most likely to provide care for a spouse

In 2018, about one-third (34%) of all senior caregivers aged 65 and older provided care primarily for their spouse, while 20% of them cared for a friend, colleague or neighbour, 17% for their own parents, 14% for other family members, 9% for their children and 6% for their parents-in-law.

Sales down by one-third at drinking places

Sales in food services and drinking places declined by one-fifth year over year (unadjusted) in September. Sales were down by over half at special food services, one-third at drinking places and one-quarter at full-service restaurants. Sales at limited-service restaurants were down by 6.9%.
