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PREFACE

The general purpose of this bibliography is to provide a relatively comprehensive and flexible information database for use in Fraser River estuary water quality planning activities. The Fraser River estuary is defined as the land and water outside the boundary of the dykes and between Kanaka Creek and the outlet of Pitt Lake in the east, the estuary drop of in the west, Point Grey to the north and the international boundary to the south, including Boundary Bay and Semiahmoo Bay.

Although the focus was on water quality, the scope of the bibliography was broadened to include available information on the physical environment, contaminant sources, sediments, aquatic habitats, biota, and water uses. Information was acquired from government, university and private organizations, particularly through contact with individuals with direct research experience in the Fraser River estuary. On-line information database searches were used to augment the bibliography. Emphasis was placed on acquiring information published since 1978 when the most recent major literature reviews were conducted by the Fraser River Estuary Study. Unpublished information and work in progress are included in the bibliography under the principal investigator's name or organization.

The utility of this bibliography is greatly enhanced by its computer based format which allows the database to be quickly and easily updated and manipulated. Database management is currently being done with dBase II and dBase III on IBM PC/XT compatibles and with ORACLE on an IBM mainframe.

A typical citation in the bibliography would be as follows:

References can be searched by AUTHOR, TITLE, PUBLISHER, or KEYWORDS. A REF. NO. is used to identify each reference for sorting and indexing. LOCATION indicates where the reference can be found, and CALL NO. represents its library catalogue code.

Six keywords are available for each reference to provide a more structured framework for searching through the database. Keywords are used in a hierarchical fashion to describe the references.

All references are described by a geographic location namely: Main Arm, North Arm, Sturgeon Bank, Roberts Bank, Main Stem, Boundary Bay, and Estuary (a category that encompasses more than one of the preceeding locations). The next level of keyword hierarchy consists of 10 major subject headings namely:

- o Physical Environment
- o Contaminant Sources
- o Water Quality
- o Sediments
- o Bacteria

- o Plants
- o Invertebrates
- o Fish
- o Birds
- o Water Use

For each of the above major subject headings, many different sub-headings are used to further describe the references. Since the total number of keywords used to describe each reference is limited to six, different references are described at different levels of detail. Therefore, in order to find all references on a particular topic, major keyword headings are used.

The complete listing of keywords used in this bibliography is provided in the following Table. Major subject headings are underlined. Also shown is the total number of times a keyword is used in the database.

This bibliographic printout contains 628 references. Tabs are used to divide three major sections of the bibliography. Organization of the bibliography is as follows:

- 1. References arranged alphabetically by AUTHOR.
- 2. References arranged sequentially by reference NUMBER.
- 3. A CROSS-INDEX of reference numbers organized by major subject headings.

It is anticipated that this bibliography will prove to be most useful in providing baseline information for establishing priorities and research strategies in the development of water quality programs. Information in this database can be readily searched and should be periodically updated thereby augmenting future information referral needs.
