


# **ENHANCE YOUR** WORKFORCE **Hire** an offender

When you hire an offender you are not only helping your organization by gaining a trained and certified employee, but you are also helping a person as they try to safely reintegrate back into the community as a contributing member of society.

### A Source of Skilled Labour

The majority of offenders gain valuable technical skills through job development programs before returning to the community. Once released, many offenders have received training and/or certification in one or more of the following areas:

- Construction, welding and metal trades
- Auto mechanics
- Auto body and small engine repair
- Carpentry and cabinet making
- Hairdressing
- Commercial cleaning
- Plumbing and building service
- Food preparation and service
- Landscaping and horticulture
- Textiles and painting
- Canine training
- More

CSC also provides offenders with the opportunity to complete certifications such as:

- WHMIS
- Basic and Advanced Food Safety
- First Aid
- CPR
- Fall Protection
- Forklift
