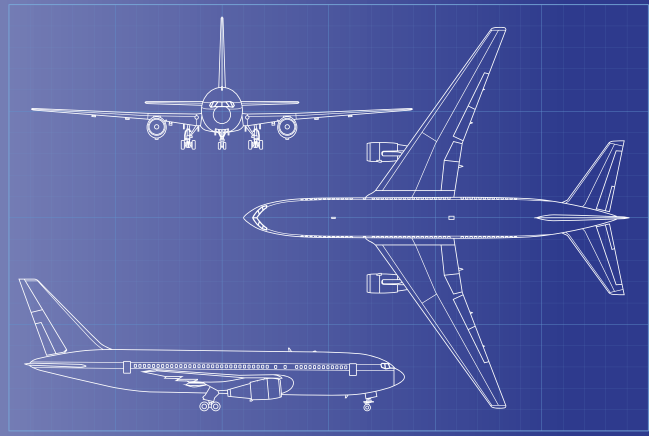


# Canadian private aircraft registrations

(as of December 31, 2020)

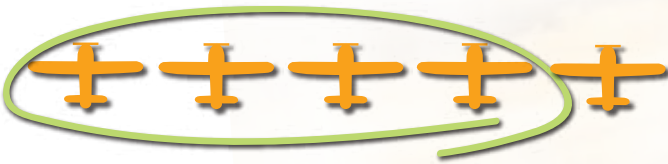


**26,598** of the **33,149\*** aircraft registered in Canada are for **private** purposes, including

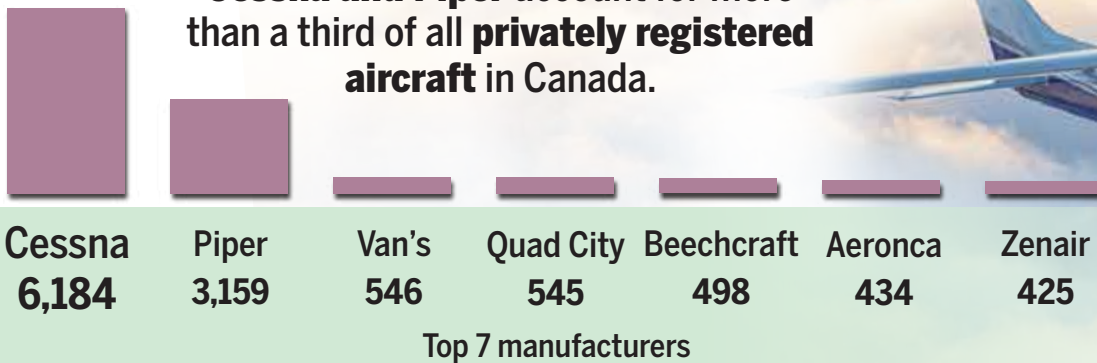

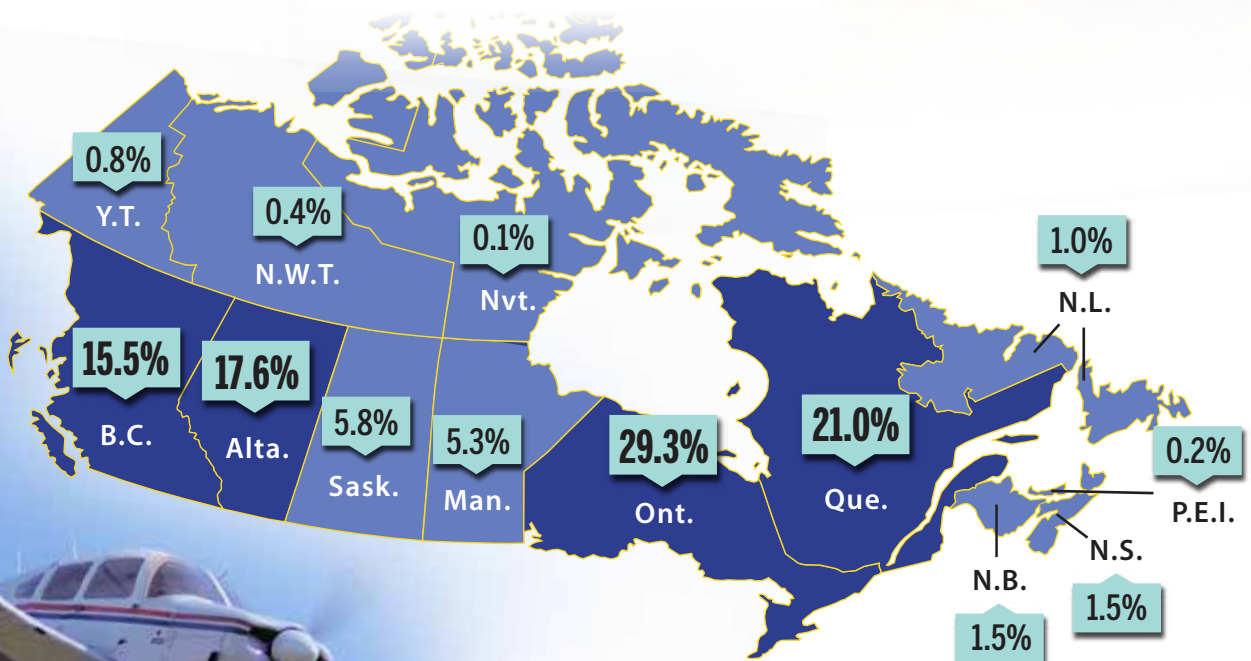
