Zero-emission vehicles in British Columbia, 2020


Battery electric vehicles (BEVs) account for the largest share of new zero-emission vehicle (ZEV) registrations in British Columbia.

New ZEV registrations represented **8.40%** (15,211) of total new vehicle registrations in British Columbia in 2020,

up from **7.8%** a year earlier.

Nevertheless, new ZEV registrations

edged down (-1,769) year over year.



Almost four-fifths of the new ZEVs registered in British Columbia in 2020

were BEVs (79.5%).



Victoria had the highest proportion of new ZEVs (**12.9%** or 1,222 vehicles), followed by Vancouver (**10.9%** or 10,594 vehicles).
