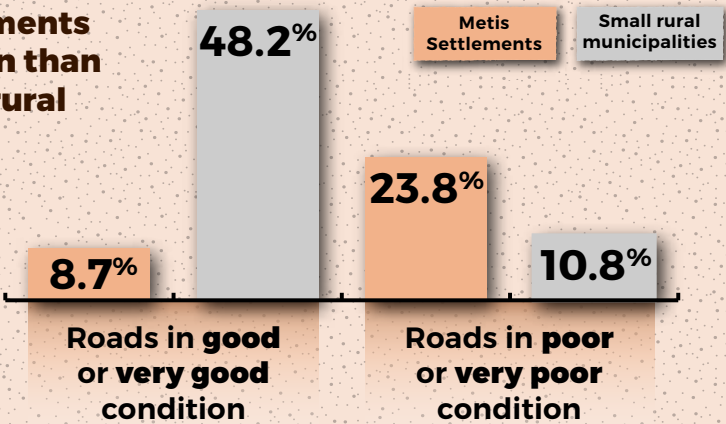




Infrastructure at a glance: Metis Settlements of Alberta, 2018

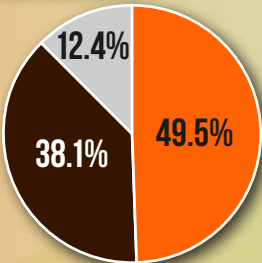
ROADS

Roads owned by the Metis Settlements of Alberta were in worse condition than the roads of the province's small rural municipalities.¹

- Indoor sports facilities



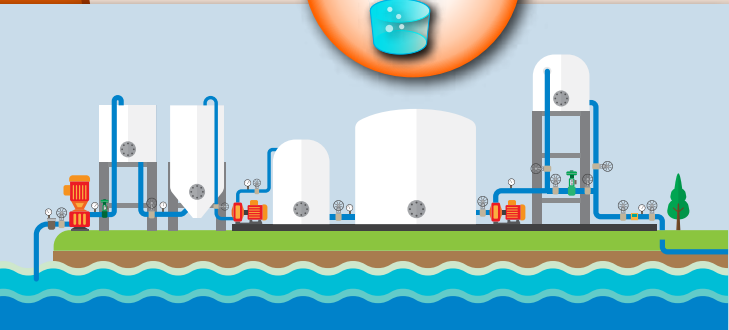
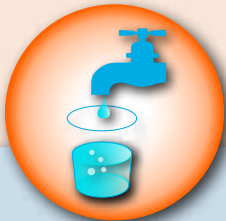
These facilities were newer than those found in the province's small rural municipalities.

WATER INFRASTRUCTURE

Water treatment facilities owned by the Metis Settlements of Alberta were in worse condition than those of small rural municipalities.

Number of potable water treatment facilities per community (average)	1.0	1.0
Number of wastewater treatment plants and lagoons per community (average)	1.3	1.5
Potable water treatment facilities in poor or very poor condition	24.4%	7.8%
Wastewater treatment plants and lagoons in poor or very poor condition	49.0%	9.6%
