



Indigenous population in Canada Projections to 2041




The population of Indigenous identity was estimated at 1.8 million in 2016.

Depending on the projection scenario, it could reach between 2.5 million and 3.2 million in 2041.





In 2041, the total Indigenous population would include 1.5 million to 1.8 million First Nations people, 0.9 million to 1.2 million Métis and 92,000 to 101,000 Inuit.



In 2041, the Indigenous population could represent 5.4% to 6.8% of the Canadian population.
In 2016, this proportion was 5.0%
