


First Nations people in Canada Projections to 2041



The First Nations population was estimated at 1.1 million in 2016.

Depending on the projection scenario, it could reach between 1.5 million and 1.8 million in 2041.




The **median age** of the First Nations population is projected to be between 36.0 and 36.5 years in 2041, up from 27.2 years in 2016.

In comparison, the median age of the non-Indigenous population is projected to increase from 41.4 to 44.7 years over the same period.


