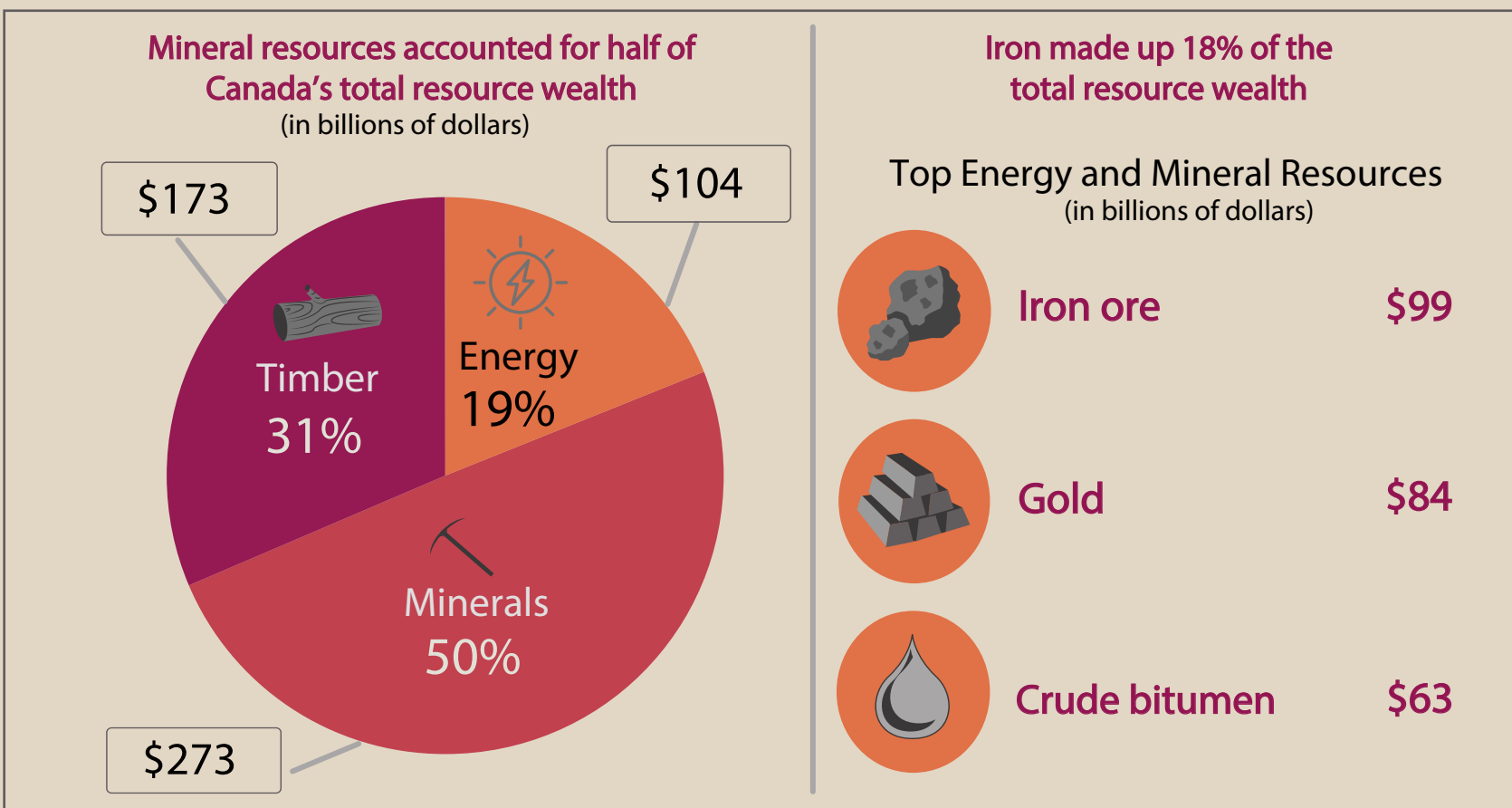


Preliminary Data on Canada's Natural Resource Wealth, 2020

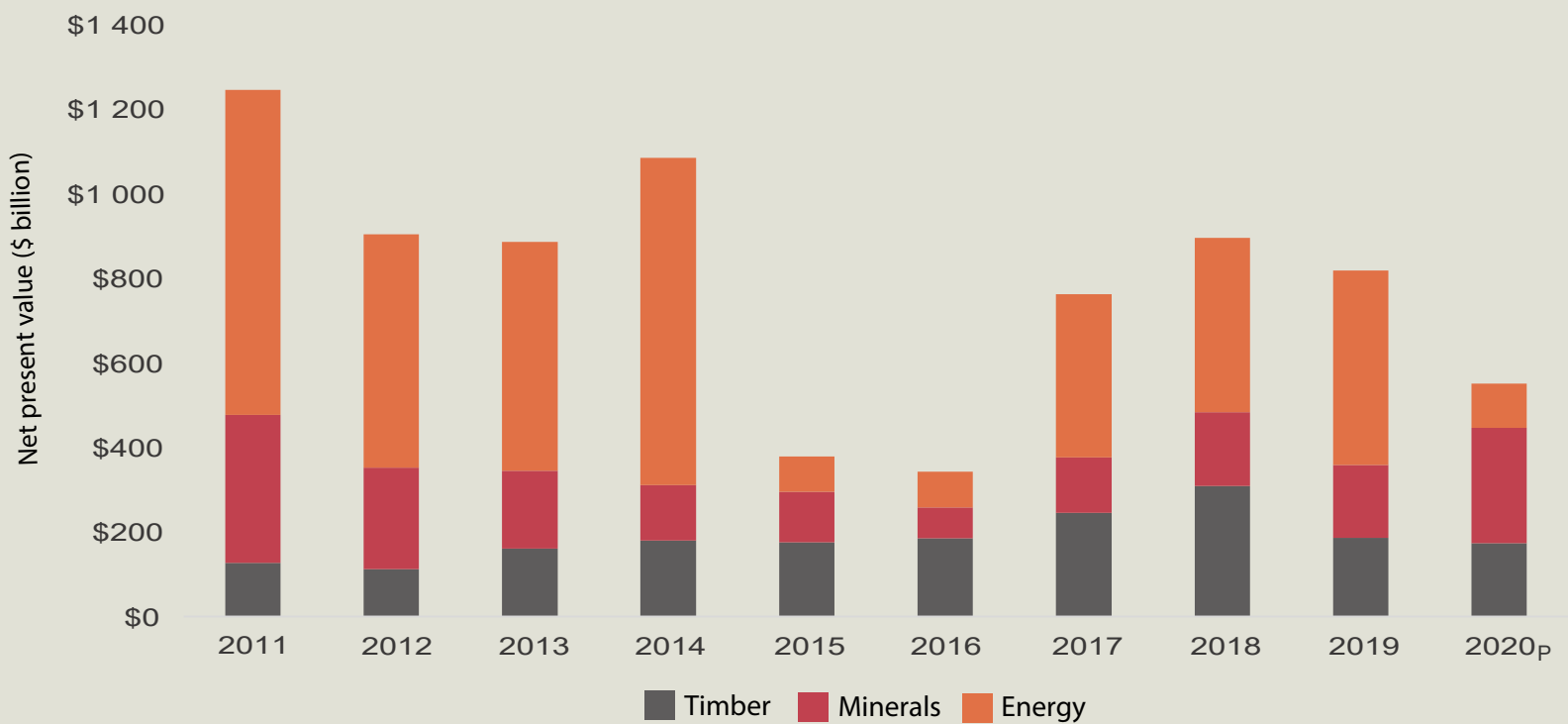


The data on natural wealth reflects reserves of energy,¹ selected minerals² and timber³ (2020 preliminary).

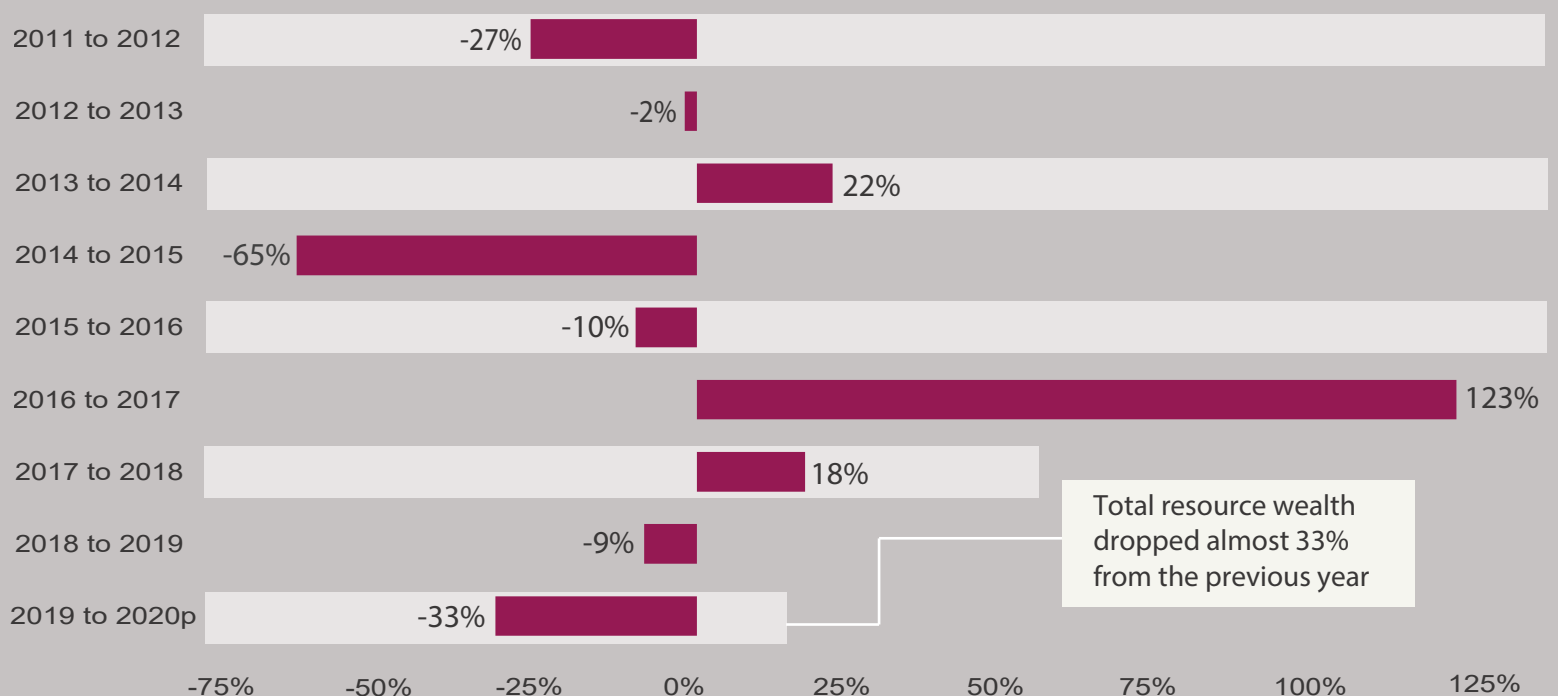
Canada's natural resource assets totalled \$550 billion in 2020
