Unvaccinated travellers entering Canada during COVID-19

Pre-border

- <u>Check that you are eligible to enter Canada</u>
- Travellers must also meet all other entry criteria, including:
 - submitting all required COVID-19 information into <u>ArriveCAN</u> prior to travel (if arriving by air, information must be submitted **before** boarding a flight)
 - meeting the pre-entry testing requirements
 - being asymptomatic upon arrival
 - having a suitable quarantine plan,
- Within 72 hours **before** your arrival to Canada or **prior to the scheduled departure** of your flight to Canada:
 - Take a pre-entry <u>COVID-19 molecular test</u> (Antigen tests are not accepted for entry) or have proof of a positive test result received in the past 10-180 days
 - Use <u>ArriveCAN</u> to enter your information
- Air travellers are strongly encouraged to pre-register for arrival testing before their flight to Canada.



At the border

- Provide all required information and documents, including:
 - ArriveCAN receipt
 - pre-entry COVID-19 molecular test results
 - other travel documents
- Answer all eligibility, vaccination and health screening questions.
- If you have symptoms or do not meet requirements, follow the instructions provided by the government representative.
- Follow the instructions upon entry to complete an Arrival test. This test may be conducted at the airport, offsite or may be a take-home self-swab kit.

What you need to enter into ArriveCAN:

- Identification, including your passport or other travel document
- Contact & travel information
- 14-day travel history
- Quarantine plan
- Confirmation of a negative pre-entry test (or positive test taken 10-180 days before travel)
- COVID-19 symptom self-assessment

After entry

- Complete your mandatory 14-day quarantine in a suitable location, such as your home. If you do not have a suitable location, you may be sent to a designated quarantine facility.
- Take an additional test on day 8 of your mandatory 14-day quarantine.
- Follow the handout given to you at time of entry, as well as all additional federal, provincial/territorial and local public health measures, including wearing a well-constructed mask en route to your place of quarantine.
- Answer compliance verification calls from the Government of Canada. You may also receive a visit at your place of quarantine.
- If you test positive, develop symptoms, or are exposed to someone with signs and symptoms of COVID-19 during the next 14 days, you are required to isolate for 10 days from the time the positive test was taken, the start of symptoms, or starting the day of exposure. You also need to contact the Public Health Agency of Canada at 1-833-641-0343 within 24 hours.
