

# Entering Canada by pleasure craft (recreational boat) during COVID-19

Travellers entering Canada must follow the rules set out by the Emergency Orders under the Quarantine Act to help reduce the spread of COVID-19 and its variants.

## Before you travel

### All travellers:

- Enter your information in [ArriveCAN](#) before or upon entry to Canada.



- Visit the Canada Border Services Agency website to learn about the reporting requirements for private boaters.

### Unvaccinated travellers:

- [Find out if you can enter Canada](#). If you are eligible, plan your quarantine.



- Take a [COVID-19 test](#) before arriving to Canada.



## At the border

### All travellers:



- Report to the CBSA Telephone Reporting Centre (1-888-226-7277) or an open marine reporting site location.
- Answer all eligibility and health screening questions.



### Fully vaccinated travellers:

- Have your identification, ArriveCAN receipt and proof of vaccination ready.



### Unvaccinated travellers:

- Have your identification, ArriveCAN receipt, and pre-entry test results ready.
- Proceed directly to your place of quarantine.



## Once in Canada

### All travellers:

- You may be contacted and/or visited by Government of Canada and/or provincial and territorial officials.
- In addition to federal guidance, follow all provincial/territorial and local public health guidance.
