INTRODUCTION AND MANDATE

The Invest in Canada Hub ("Invest in Canada") is a departmental corporation, established in June 2017 under the *Invest in Canada Act*. It was formally launched in March 2018 with the coming into force of its enabling legislation. Invest in Canada's mandate, for the purpose of supporting economic prosperity and stimulating innovation in Canada, is to

- (a) promote foreign direct investment in Canada and attract and facilitate that investment; and
- (b) coordinate the efforts of the government, the private sector and other stakeholders with respect to foreign direct investment in Canada.

The Access to Information Act (the "Act") is a federal statute that provides a right of access to records under the control of certain federal government institutions, such as Invest in Canada, to Canadian citizens, permanent residents, as well as individuals and corporations located in Canada.

Invest in Canada's financial year is aligned with Treasury Board Secretariat's ("TBS") requirement that all government institutions subject to the Act report on an April 1 to March 31 reporting cycle.

This report is tabled in Parliament and prepared in accordance with section 72 of the Act.

ORGANIZATIONAL STRUCTURE

During the 2018-2019 reporting period, the Privacy & ATI functions were performed by both the communications division and corporate services. The communications division, comprised of two (2) full-time employees, Communications Manager and the Communications Officer is responsible for receiving and processing any requests. The Corporate Services team is responsible for approving the requests. Invest in Canada's Chief Operations Officer is the head of the institution responsible for Privacy and Access to Information.

DELEGATION OF AUTHORITY

The Chief Executive Officer (CEO) is designated as the head of the department for the purposes of the Act.

Pursuant to section 72 of the Act, the CEO's authority has been delegated to enable the Corporation to meet its legislated requirements. The CEO has delegated most of his powers and duties to the COO.

As requested by TBS, a copy of the delegation order is appended hereto.

STATISTICAL REPORT

As requested by TBS, the appended Statistical Reports exceptionally cover the period from April 1, 2018 to March 31, 2019. No requests for information under the Act were received during this period.

TRAINING AND AWARENESS PROGRAM

During the reporting period, the Corporate Services Team promoted awareness of the department's obligations under the Act through a variety of training approaches provided in both official languages.

INSTITUTION SPECIFIC POLICIES, GUIDELINES AND PROCEDURES

As Invest in Canada is a new federal organization, it is working on developing and implementing policies, guidelines and processes related to the Act.

COMPLAINTS AND INVESTIGATIONS

There were no complaints received by Invest in Canada and no investigations of complaints were conducted by the Office of the Information Commissioner.

MONITORING THE TIME TO PROCESS ACCESS TO INFORMATION REQUESTS (AND REQUESTS FOR THE CORRECTION OF PERSONAL INFORMATION)

Invest in Canada did not receive any requests under the Act during the reporting period.

PRIVACY BREACHES

No privacy breaches occurred during the reporting period.

ASSESSING PRIVACY IMPACT

Invest in Canada did not complete and forward any Privacy Impact Assessments to the Privacy Commissioner's Office.
