INTRODUCTION

While many specific product-sourcing questions cannot be answered directly in this publication, it is hoped that it will quickly lead the reader to a source where answers can be found.

The publication is structured as follows:

Section I lists the national industry associations that have a significant number of distribution companies as members. Often these associations will be the best source of information and material on those companies and products within their areas of specialty. The information in this section was obtained from a survey of trade associations and is arranged alphabetically;

Section II specifies directories that list retailers, wholesalers and/or distributors in Canada. In many cases, these directories are published by a trade periodical and are contained in regular annual issues (or special edition issues). When this is the case, the name of the trade magazine is given in parentheses immediately following the name of the directory. Directories that do not specifically identify firms as wholesalers, distributors or retailers are not listed here;

Section III identifies sources of retail and wholesale statistics in Canada; and

The Annex contains the addresses and telephone numbers of the publishers of the directories and periodicals.
