In April 2020, the passenger load factor (or ratio of passenger-kilometres to available seat-kilometres) fell to a **historic low of 26.0%** and **remained below 50%** for the rest of the year.



Goods revenue represented 44.0% of total operating revenue in the second quarter of 2020. Previously, it consistently accounted for less than 10%.
