Evictions in Canada, 2021

In 2021,¹ 7% of Canadian Housing Survey respondents² reported being evicted in the past.

37% by landlord



26% Sale of property Landlord wanted the unit for own use



13% Conflict with the landlord



10% Demolition, conversion, or major repairs by the landlord



8% Being behind on rent payments
