



The 2017 Canadian Survey on Disability (CSD)¹ collected data on experiences of persons with disabilities. The CSD is based on a social model of disabilities, which considers disability to be the result of the interaction between a person's functional limitations and barriers in the environment, including social and physical barriers that make it harder to function day to day. Data from the 2022 CSD will provide updated information on persons with disabilities in Canada; results will be available in 2023.
