Nearly 1 in 5 college students in Canada had previously completed a bachelor's degree or higher.


Close to 1 in 10




Canadian-born college¹ students had previously completed a bachelor's degree or higher.

More than 1 in 3 immigrant college¹ students had previously completed a bachelor's degree or higher.








Among college¹ students, women were more likely than men to have a previous bachelor's degree or higher.²
