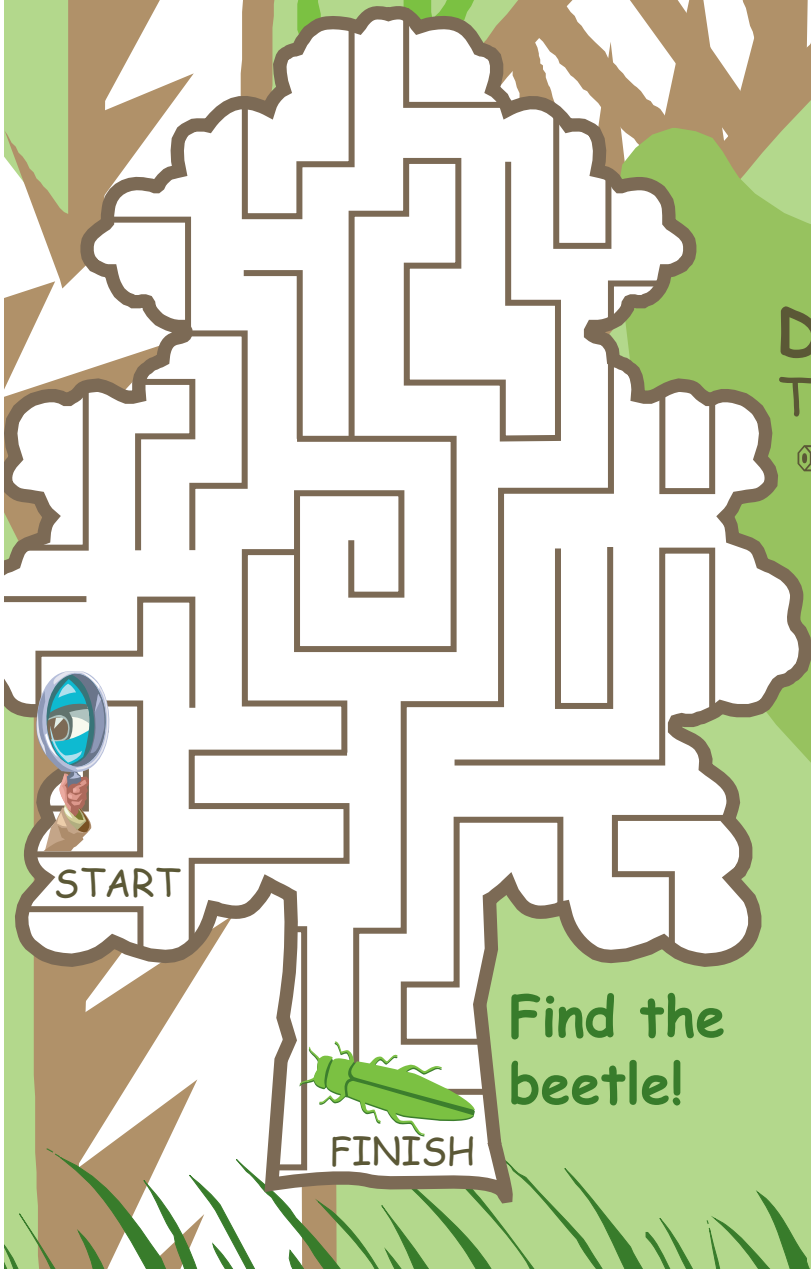
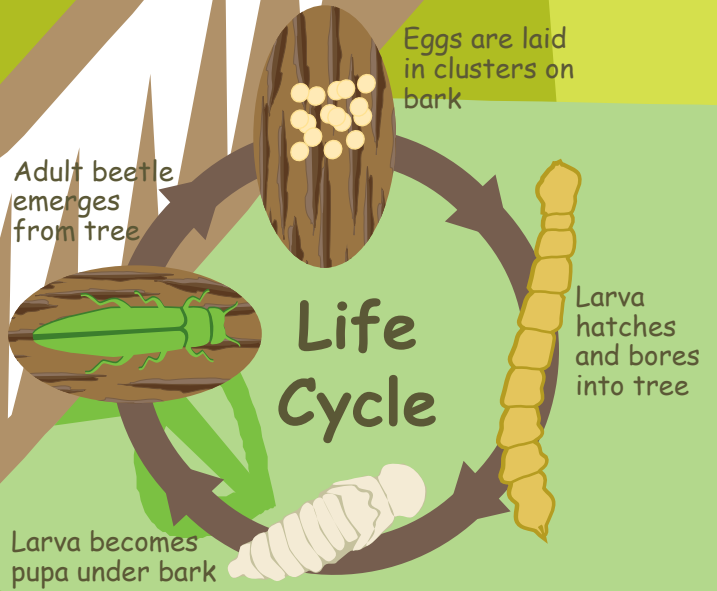


# EMERALD ASH BORER

- ➦ can lay up to 275 eggs

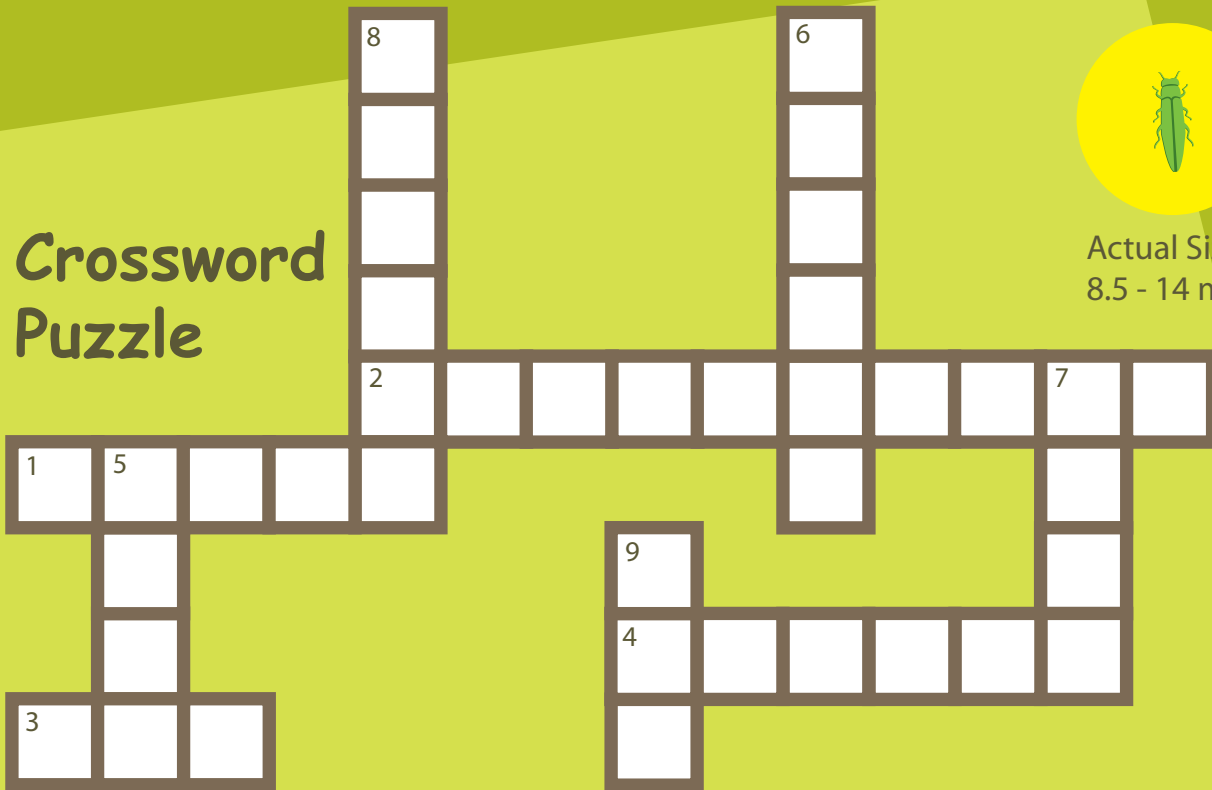
