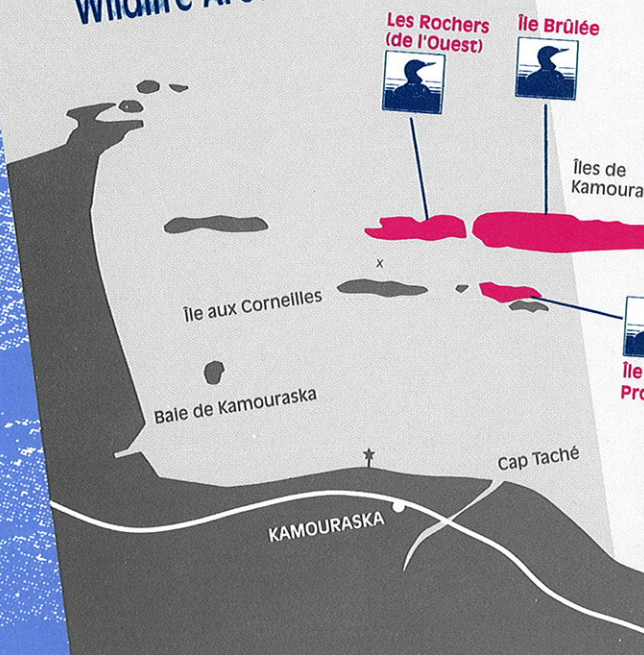

NOTICE

Some of the islands between Kamouraska and Bic form the Îles de l'estuaire National Wildlife Area. These islands are important nesting grounds for certain species of migratory birds. Any disruption or degradation of their habitat can hinder their reproduction.

On a National Wildlife Area unless you have obtained a permit which authorizes such activities, the following activities are prohibited :

- enter any National Wildlife Area
- hunting, trapping or fishing
- allowing any dog or cat to run at large
- cutting, picking, removing or willfully damaging any vegetation

- recreational activities such as camping, picnicking or having campfires
- dumping or depositing any rubbish, waste material or substance that would degrade or alter the quality of the environment
- destroying or molesting any wildlife
- possession of any wildlife or carcass, nest, egg or parts of thereof
