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Introduction

This survey is an up-date of a similar review published by the Department in June 1974. The purpose is to provide a measure of the availability of unleaded gasoline at retail outlets throughout Canada as of May of this year and to provide an indication of what may be expected in May 1976.

Survey Method Employed

The following 22 companies were involved with the current survey:

The same geographic areas were used as in the 1974 survey. These had been obtained by dividing the country on a purely arbitrary basis into 64 geographic areas, some of which were wholly urban. In selecting these areas, the desire for detailed information was balanced against the need to maintain confidentiality of marketing plans of individual companies and also against a desire to keep the number of pieces of data to a manageable size.

Each company was requested to supply the following information for each area in which it had retail outlets, including outlets of wholly-owned subsidiaries:

- Actual number of total branded retail outlets as of May 1, 1975 and the forecast number for May 1, 1976.
- 2. Actual number of outlets at which unleaded gasoline was available as of May 1, 1975 and the forecast number for May 1, 1976.

Survey Results

The composite data obtained as a result of this survey are given in the attached tables.

For the country as a whole, unleaded gasoline was available at over 6,300 retail outlets as of May 1, 1975, and this represented 23% of the total 27,500 retail outlets covered by this survey. The surveyed companies plan to add an additional 850 unleaded gasoline outlets by May 1, 1976 so that this type of gasoline will then be available at 26% of the total gasoline retail outlets.

As expected, the distribution of unleaded gasoline outlets is not uniform throughout the country. In urban areas and along such heavily-travelled roads as Ontario's Highway 401, unleaded gasoline is available at almost one out of every two branded retail outlets. However, in non-urban areas where fewer high volume stations exist, unleaded gasoline is available on the average at only one out of every six branded retail outlets. By May 1, 1976, this is expected to increase to one out of every five outlets.

The general observations made in the report of the June 1974 survey still appear to be valid. Unleaded gasoline is readily available to the urban motorist and to the motorist travelling on or near major roads and heavily-travelled routes. In all but the most remote parts of the country, the motorist travelling in rural areas should find sufficient unleaded outlets to meet his needs, but some planning of refueling stops will be required. It appears that the most inconvenience will continue to be experienced by those non-urban automobile owners who may live some considerable distance from the nearest unleaded gasoline outlet.
