# How Is the Program Administered?

Measurement Canada monitors accredited organizations to:

- ensure that the terms, conditions and requirements of the accreditation program are met;
- ensure that weighing and measuring devices comply with the requirements; and
- verify that accredited organizations are maintaining an effective quality assurance program.

## Who Is Eligible?

Any organization whose testing facilities are located in Canada and that is willing to comply with Measurement Canada's accreditation requirements.



### How to Apply


- Contact Measurement Canada to obtain the relevant documentation, information and application form.
- 2. Fill and submit the application form and applicable fees to Measurement Canada.
- 3. Develop and submit a quality manual that meets the requirements of *Criteria for the Accreditation* of Organizations to Perform Inspections Pursuant to the Electricity and Gas Inspection Act and the Weights and Measures Act.
