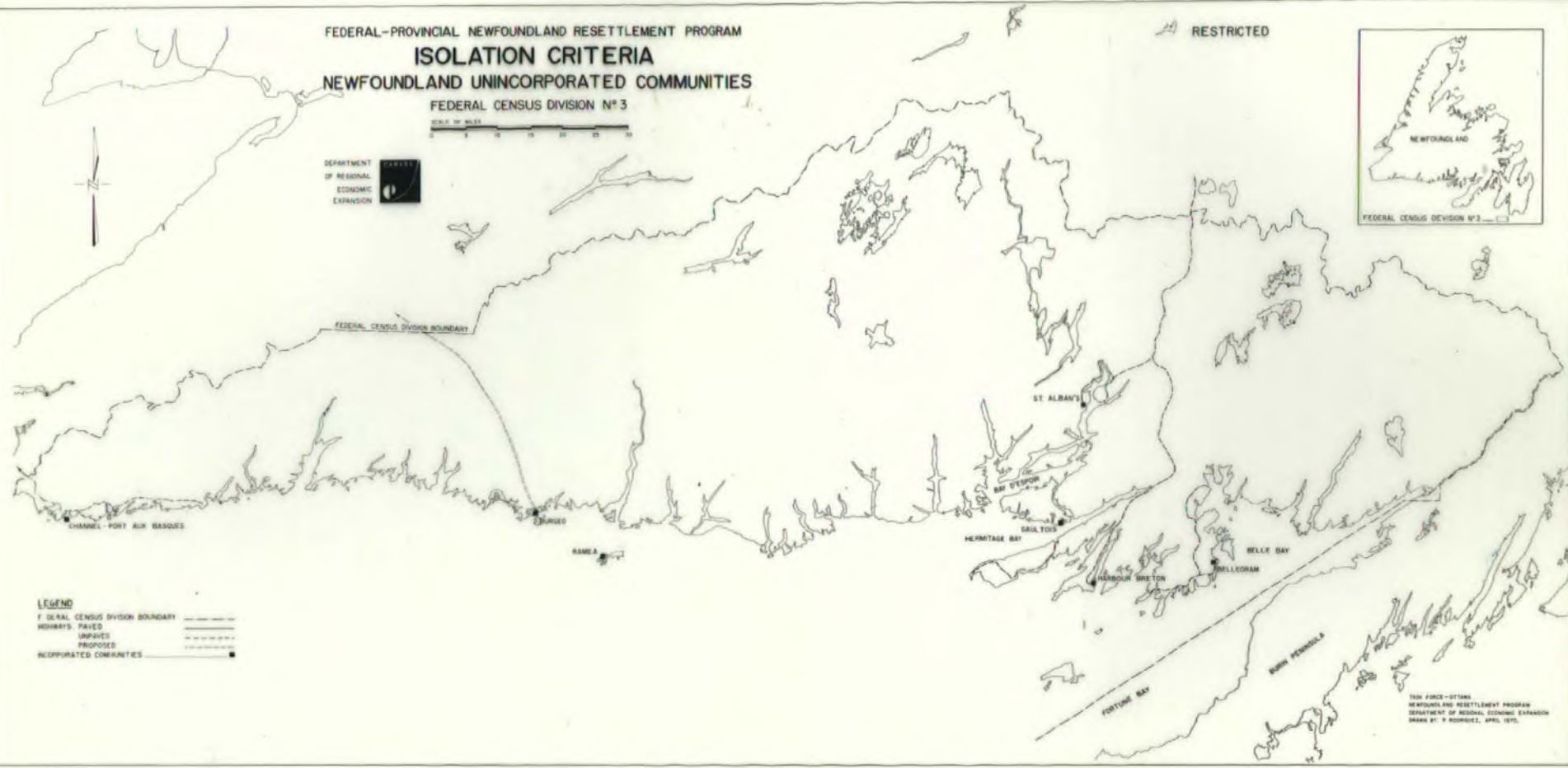

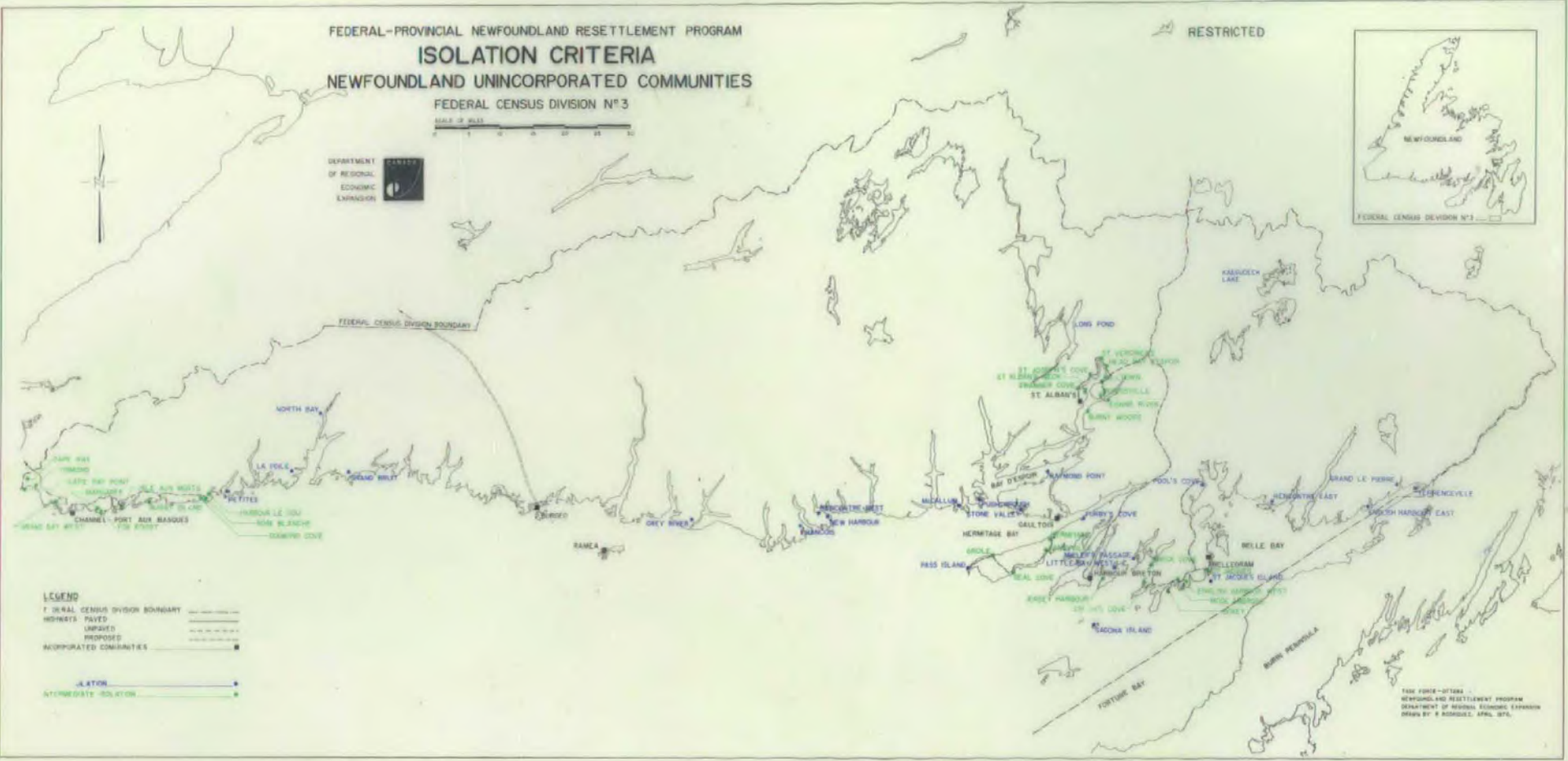

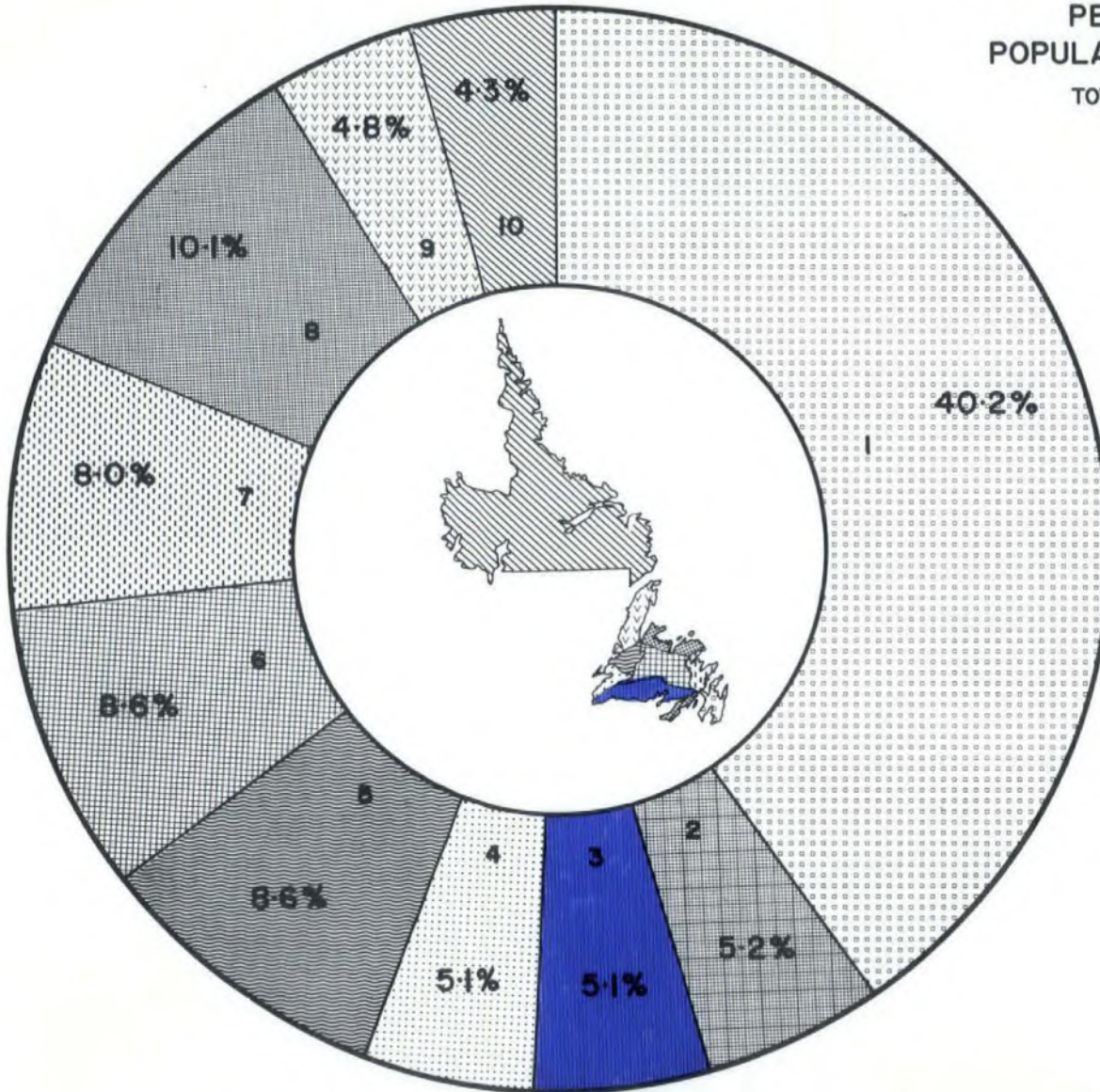

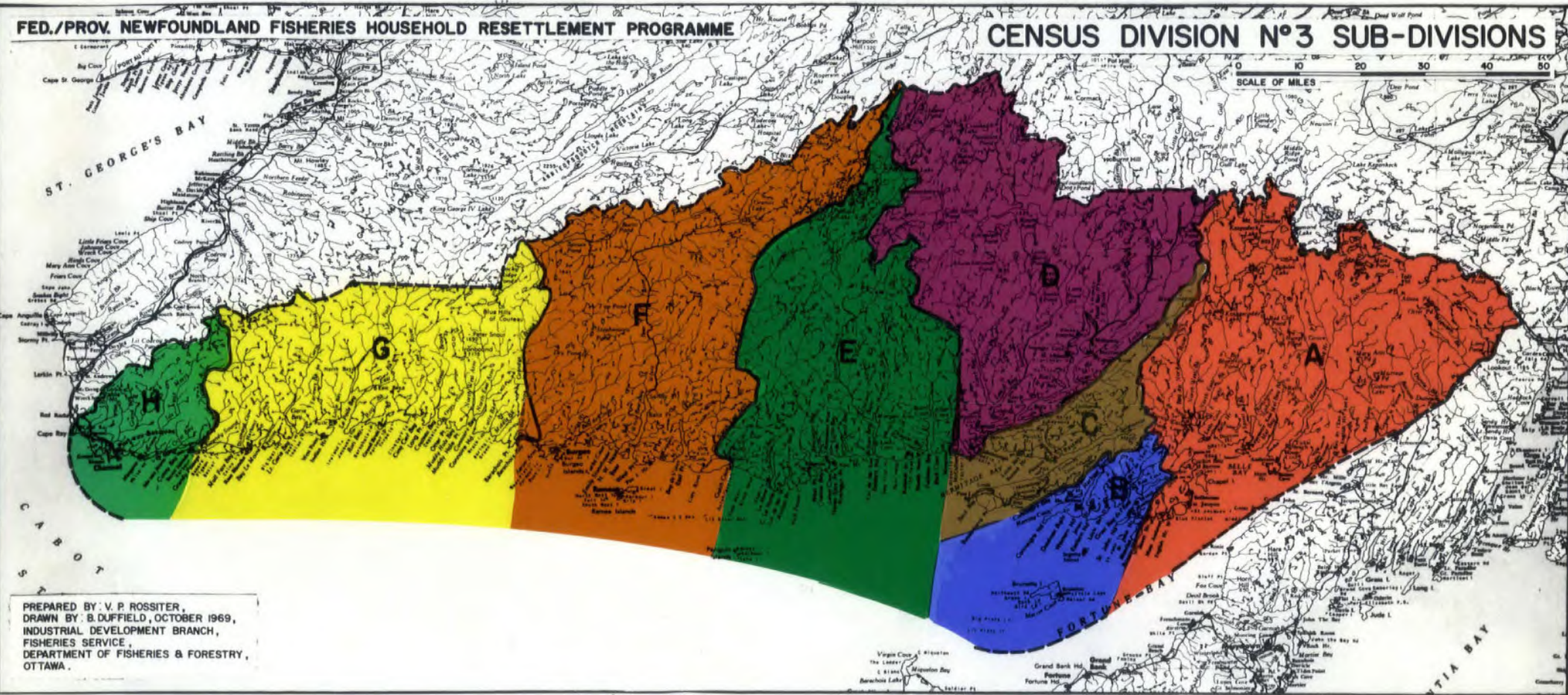

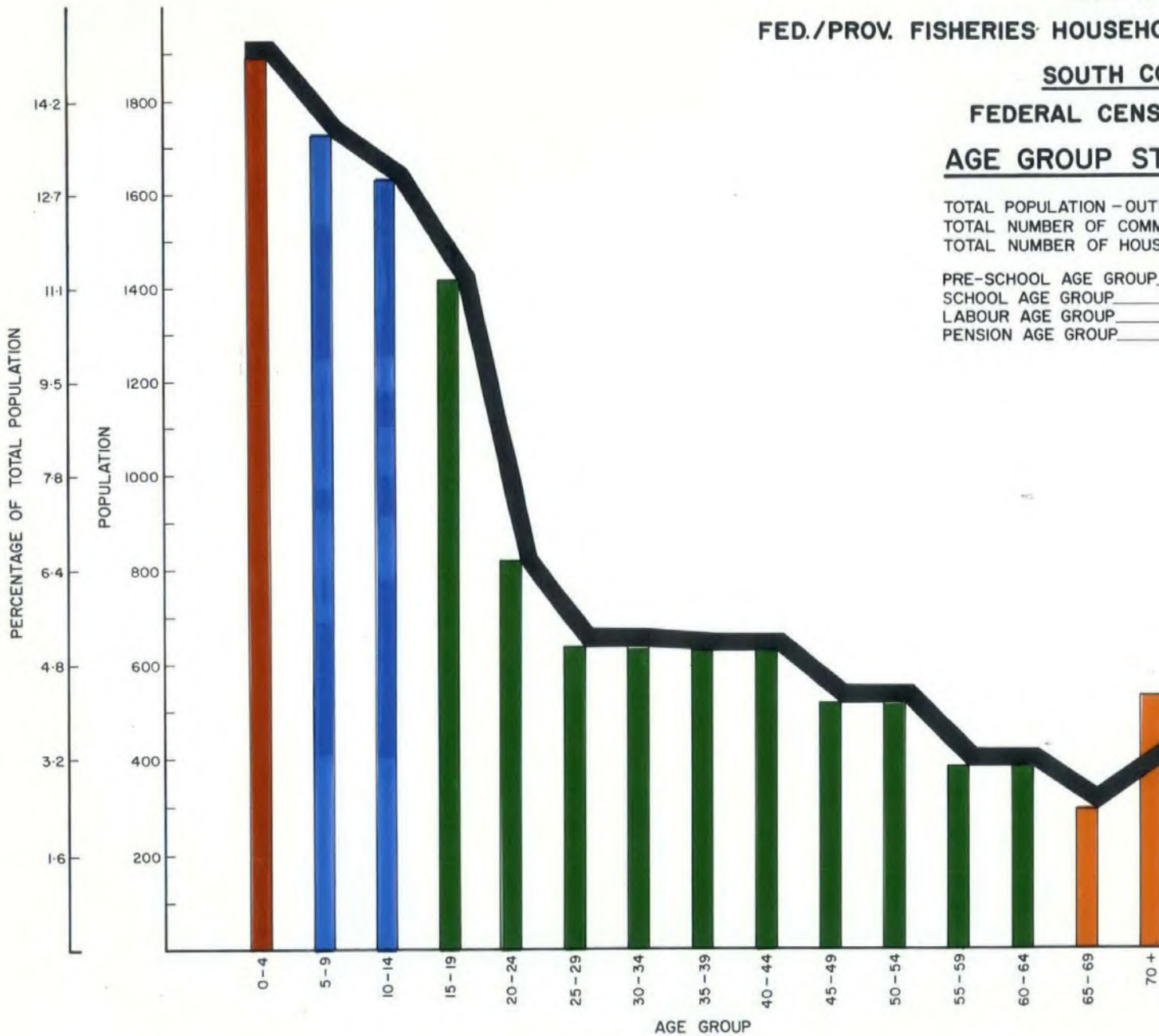

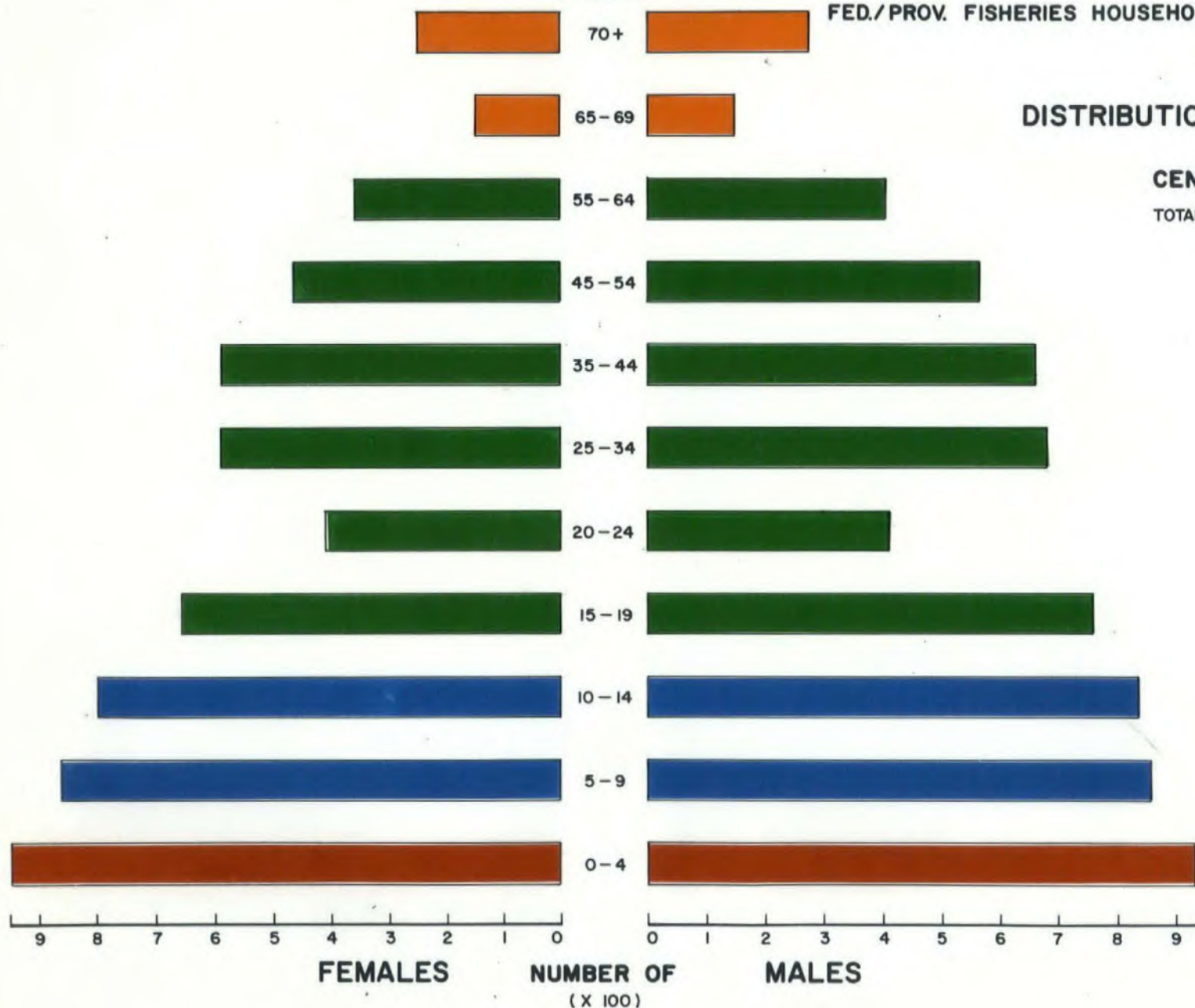

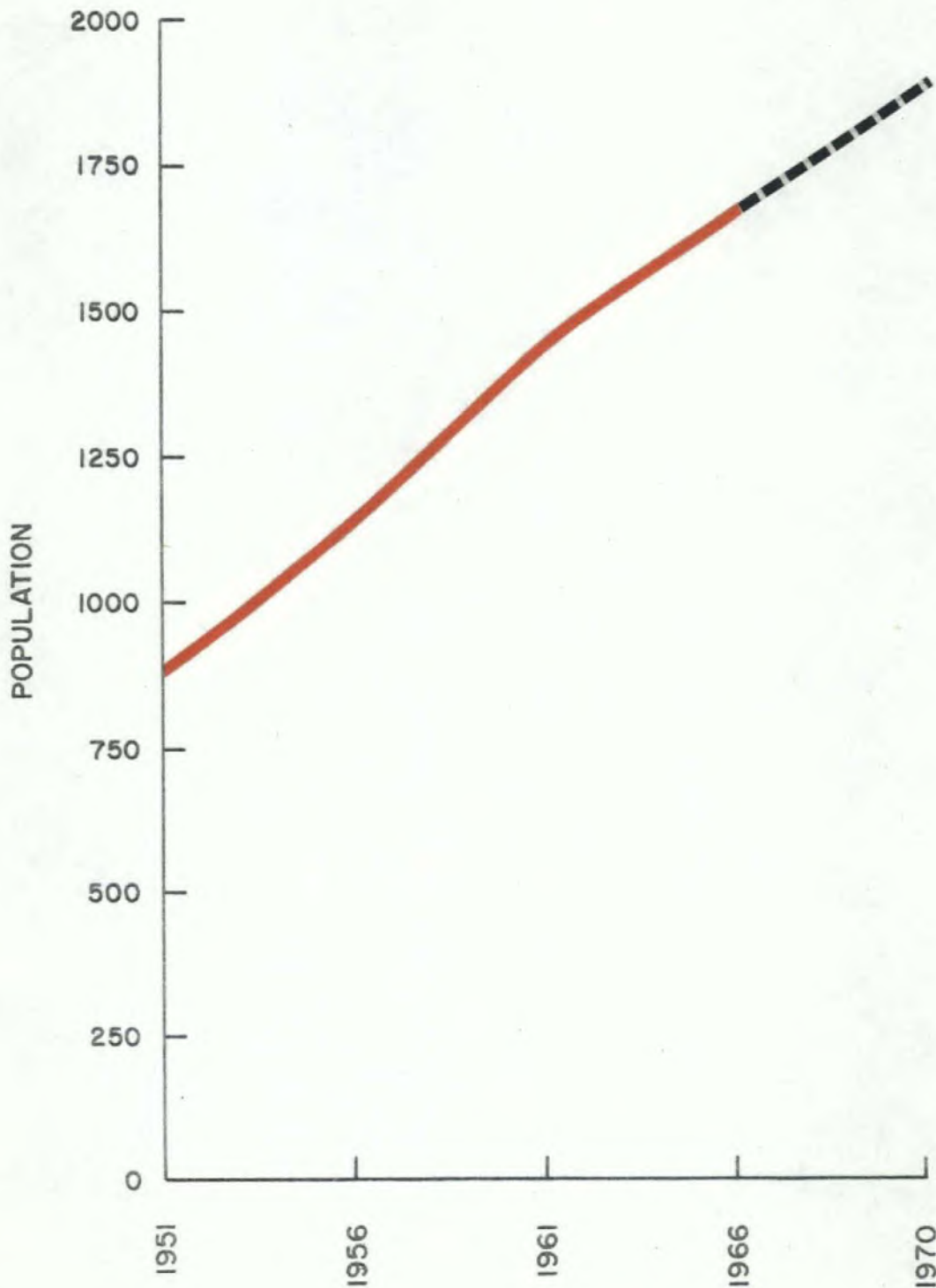

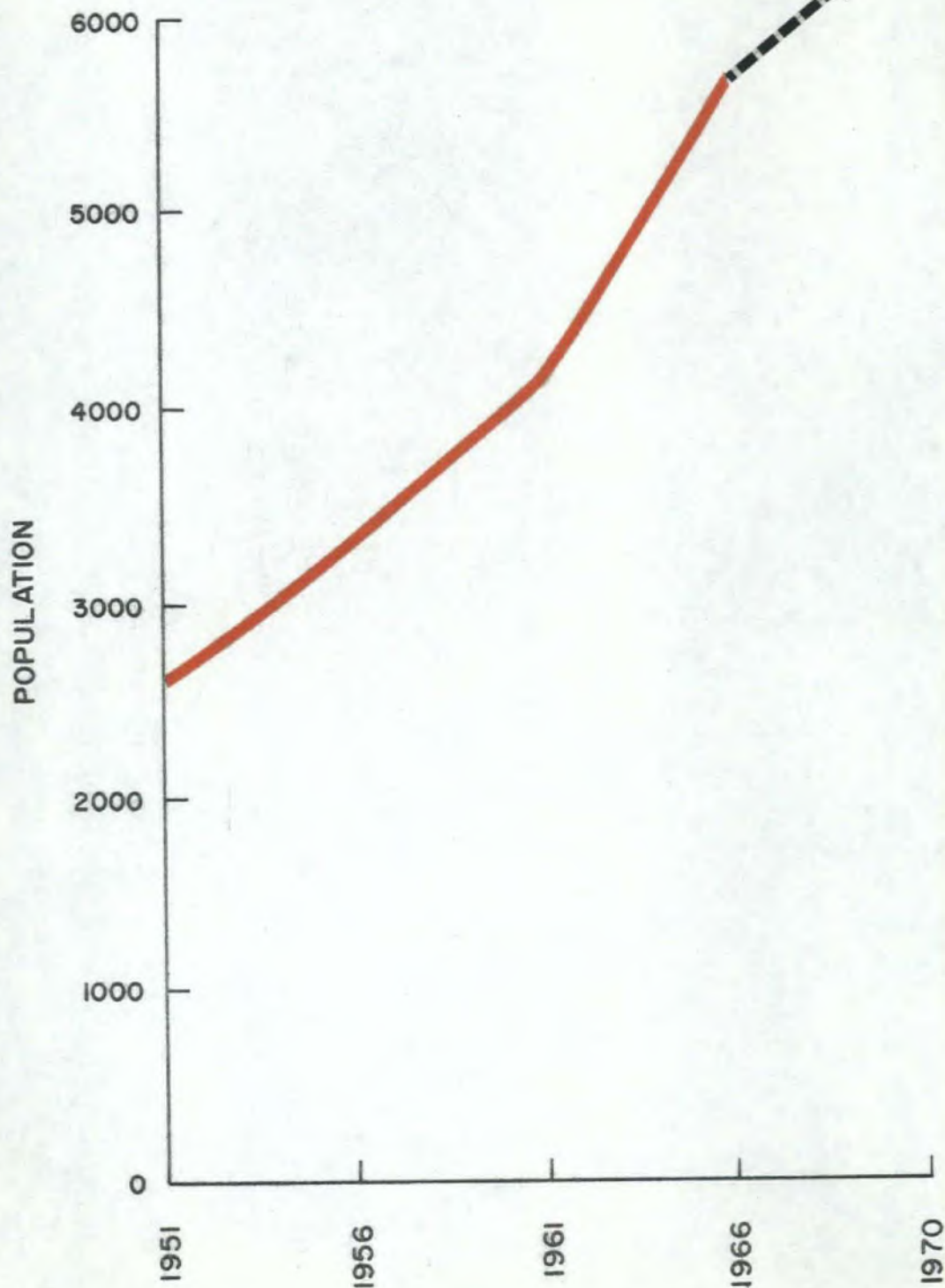

POPULATION TRENDS 1951 - 1970 BURGEO NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR



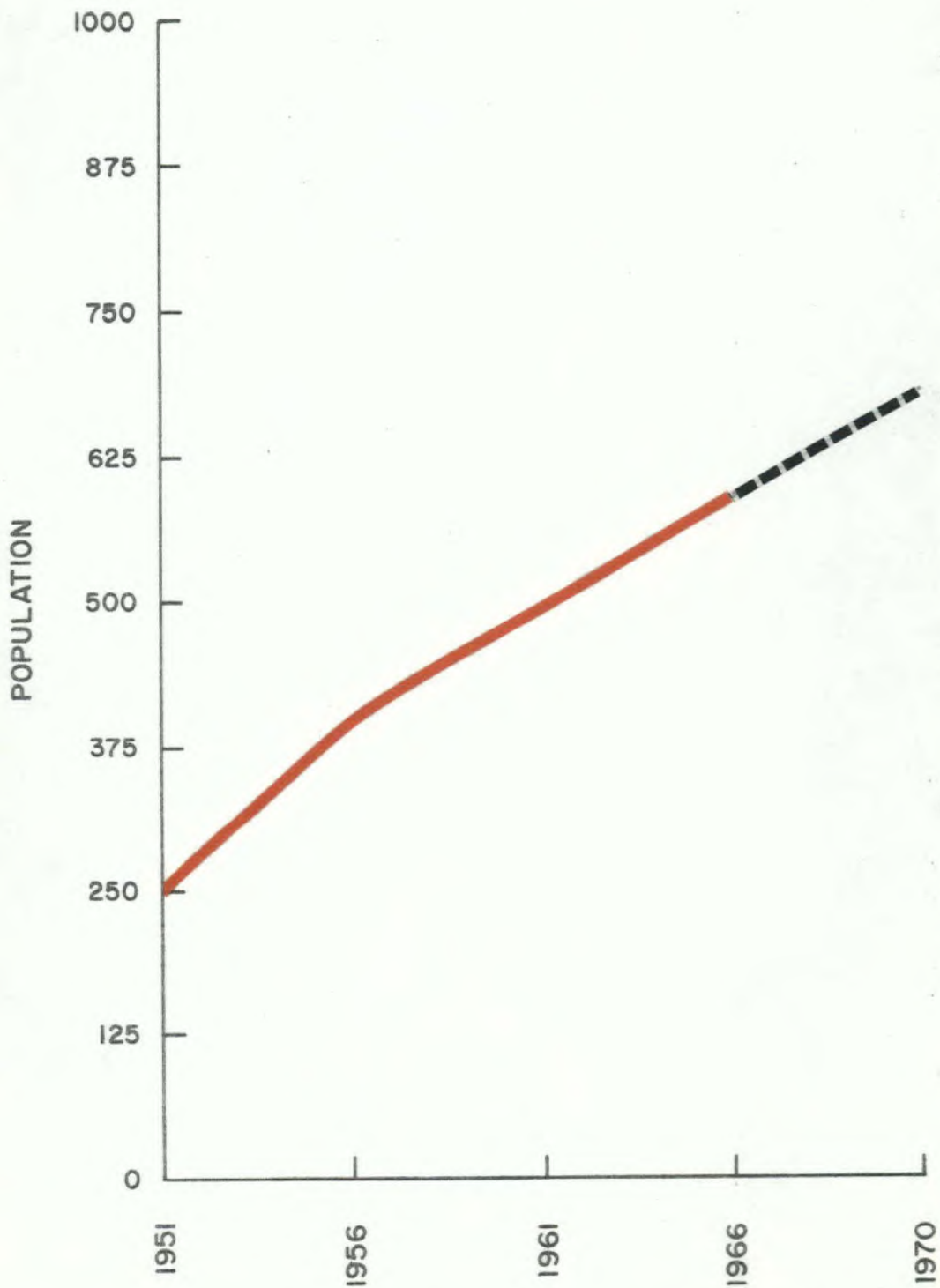

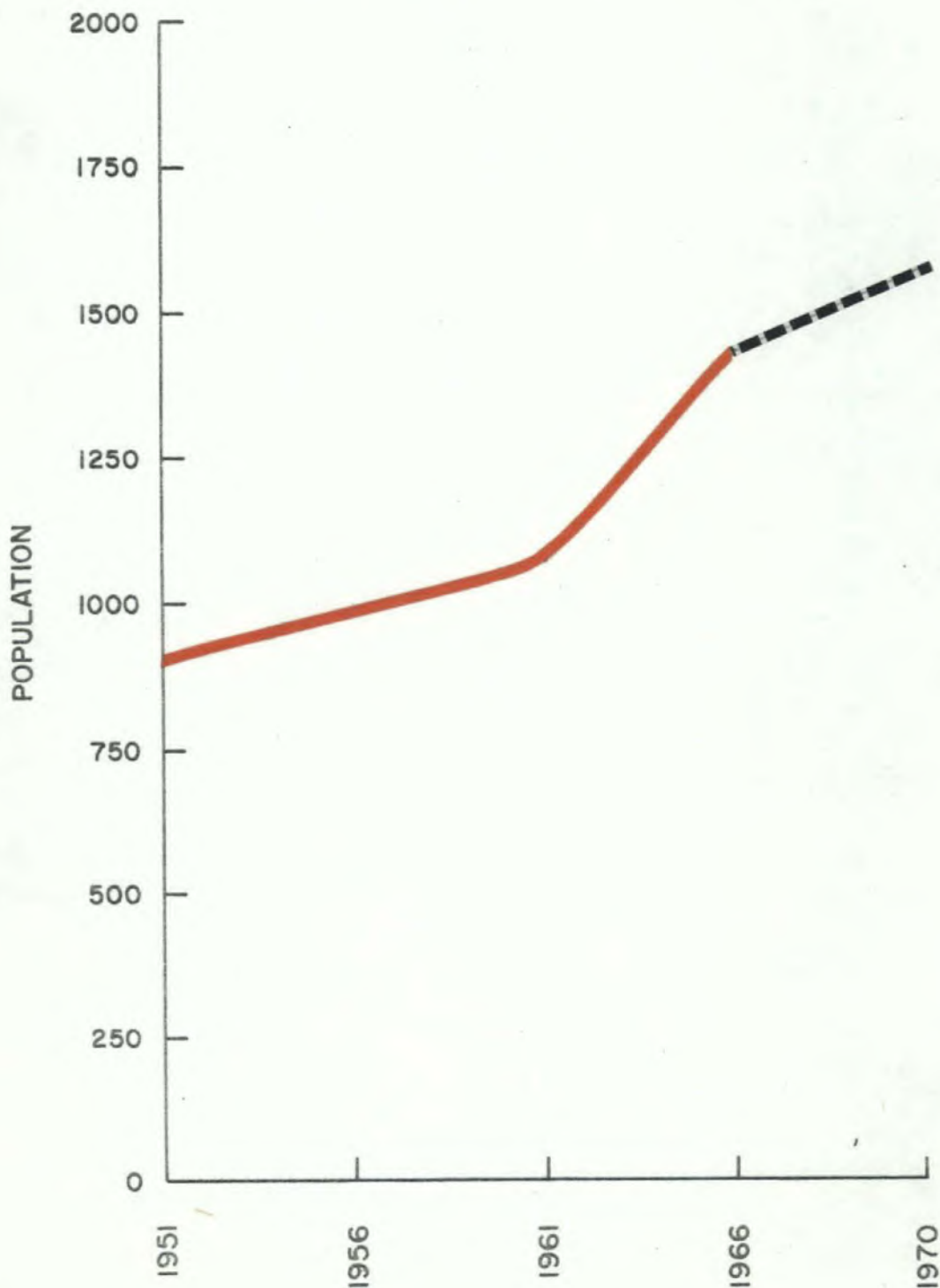

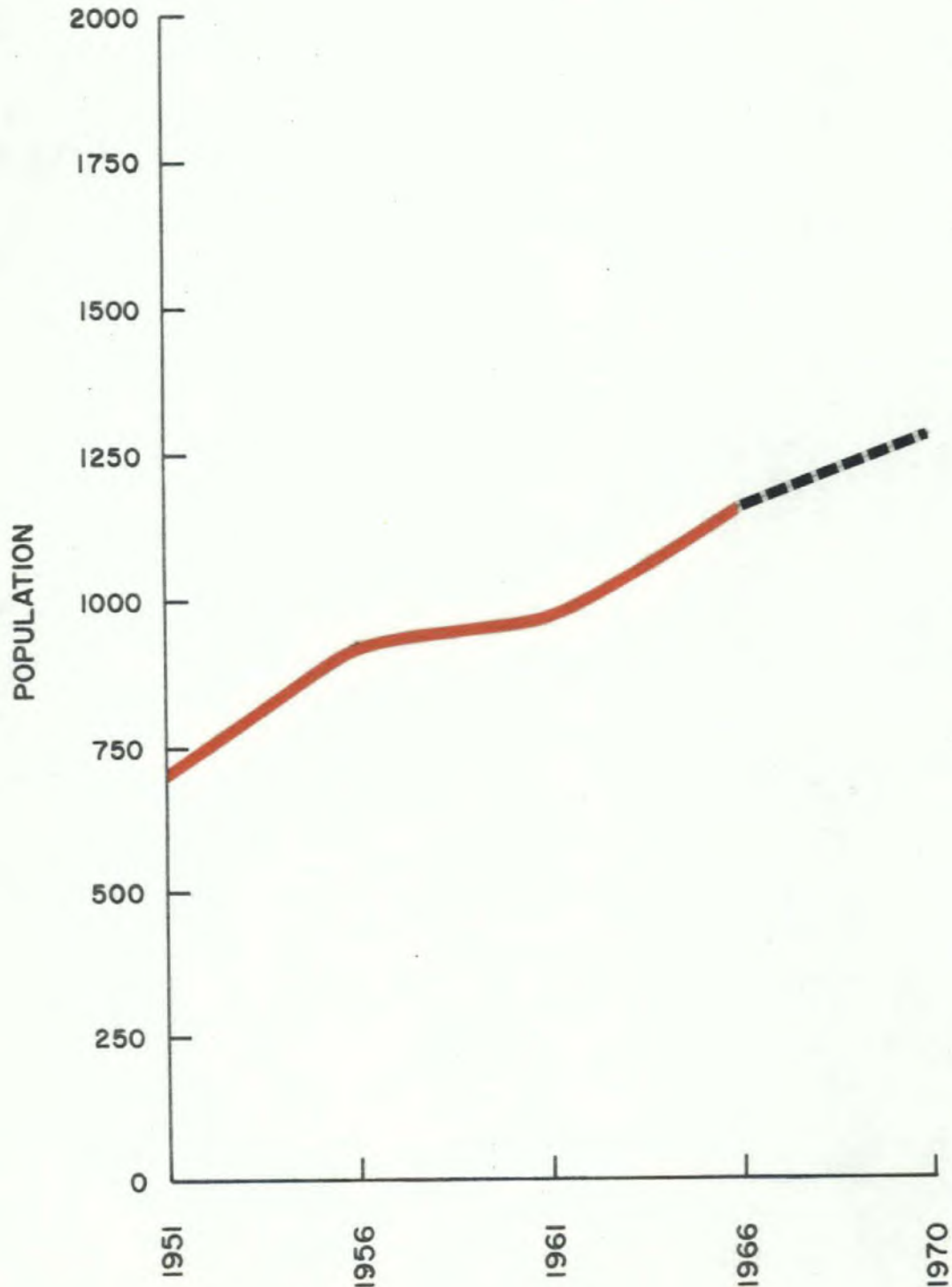

POPULATION TRENDS 1951 - 1970 HARBOUR BRETON NEWFOUNDLAND AND LABRADOR

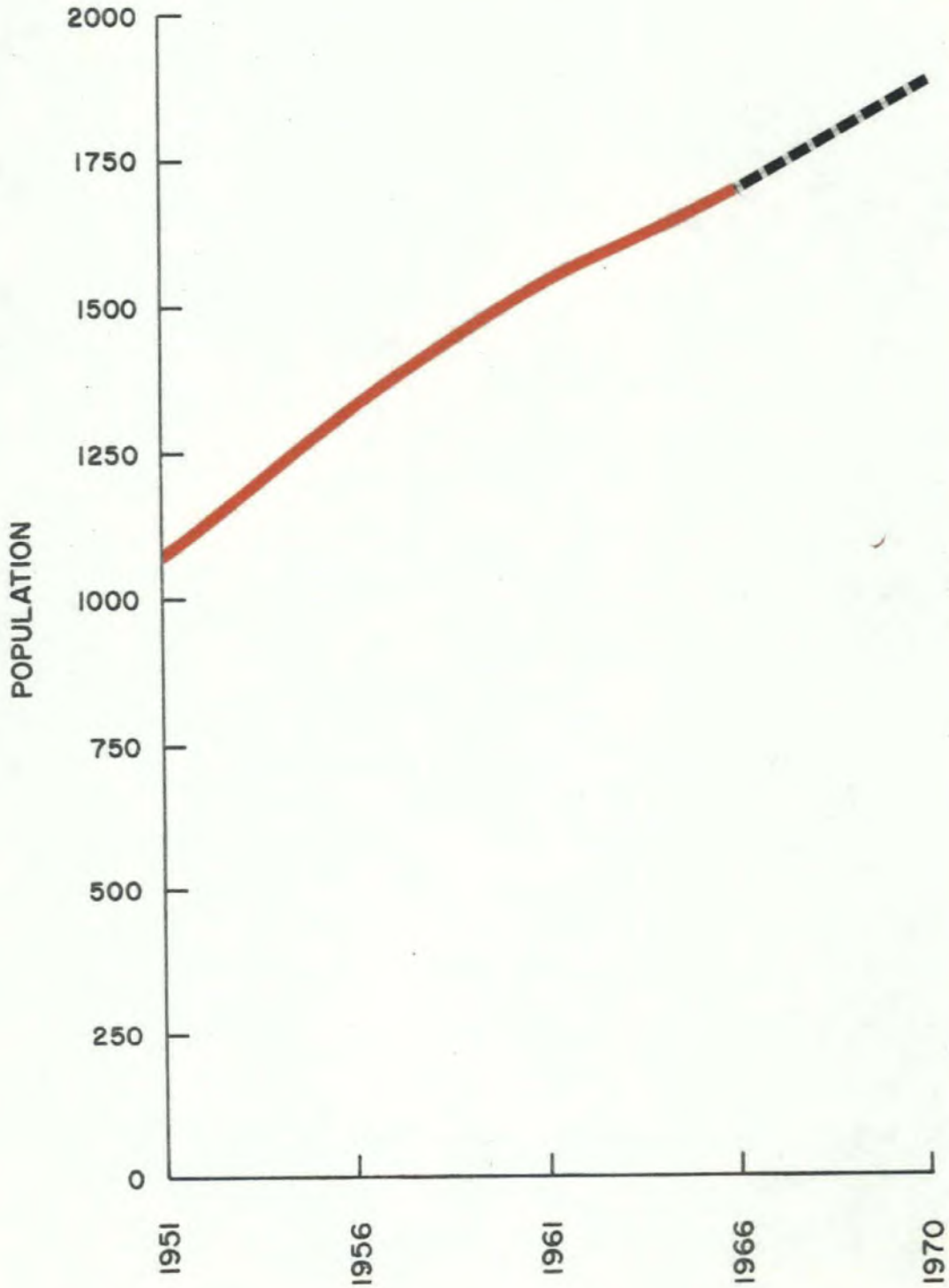

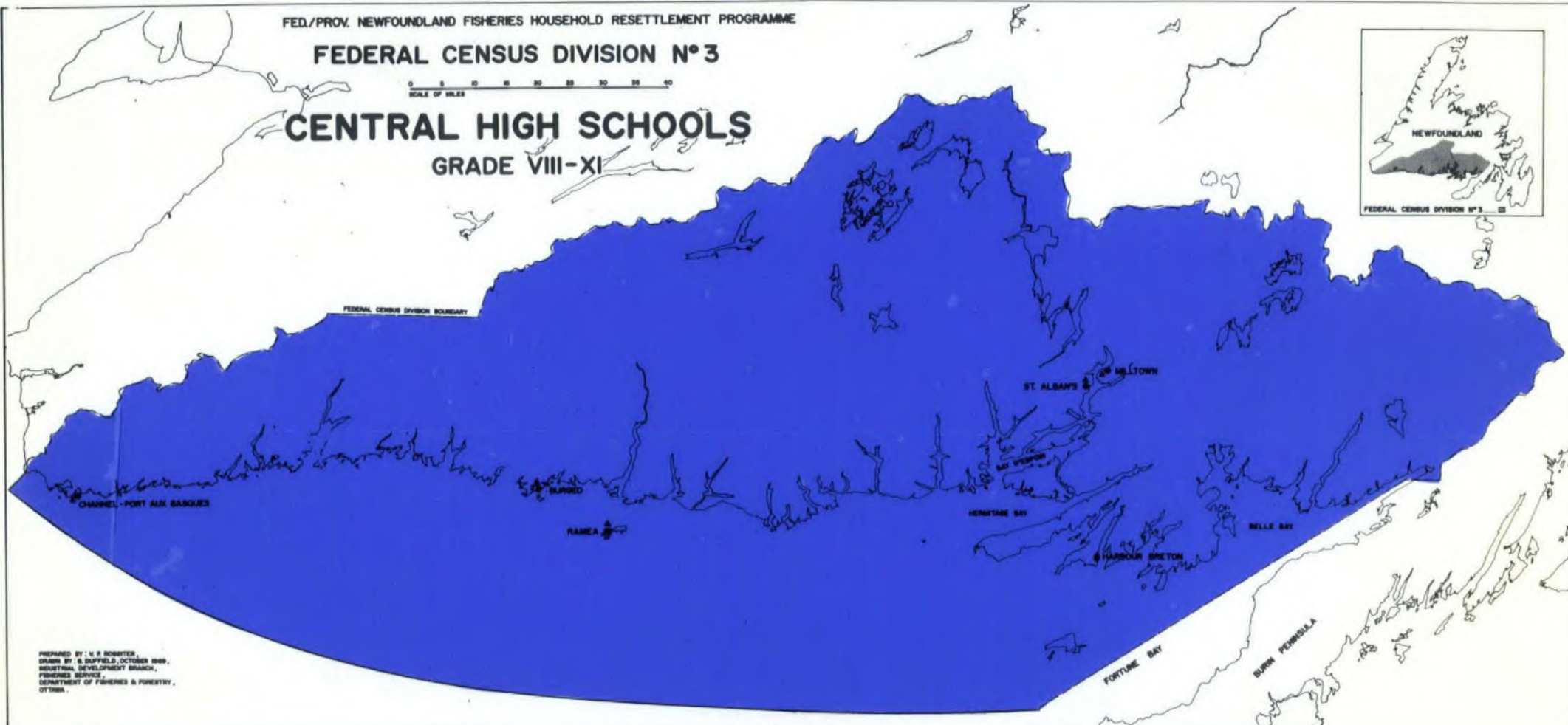

PERCENTAGE DISTRIBUTION OF SCHOOL ENROLLMENT 1967-68

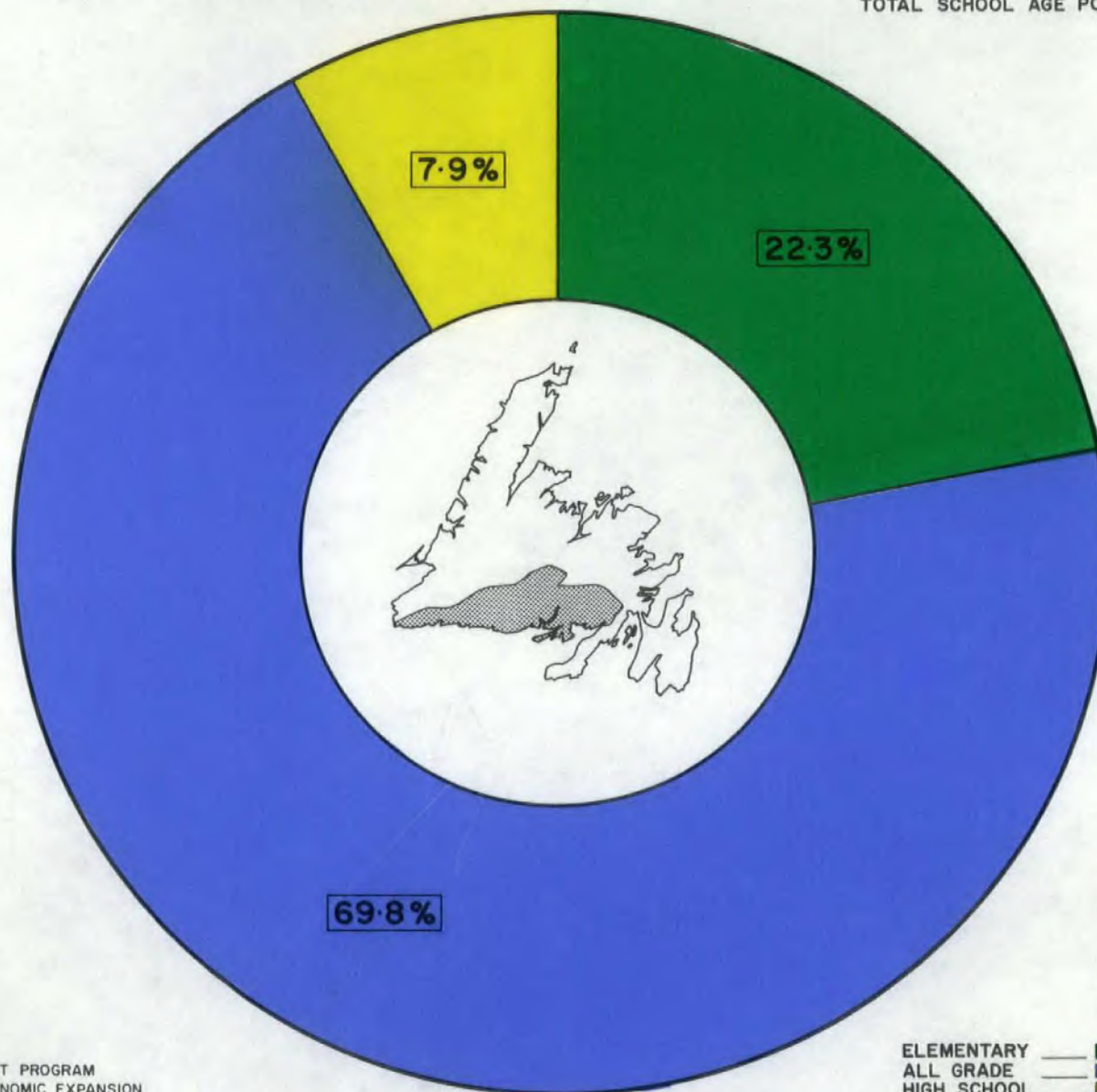

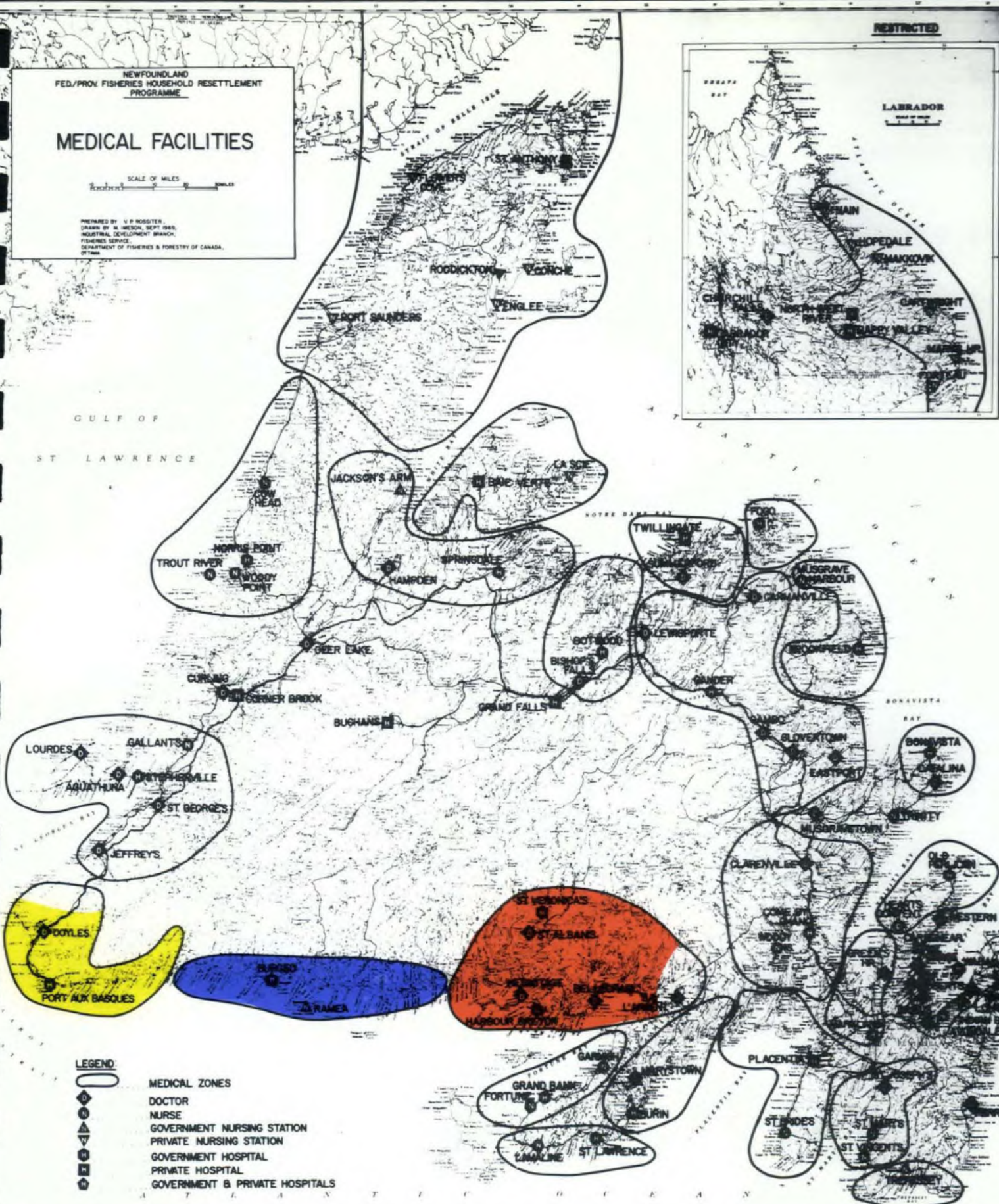

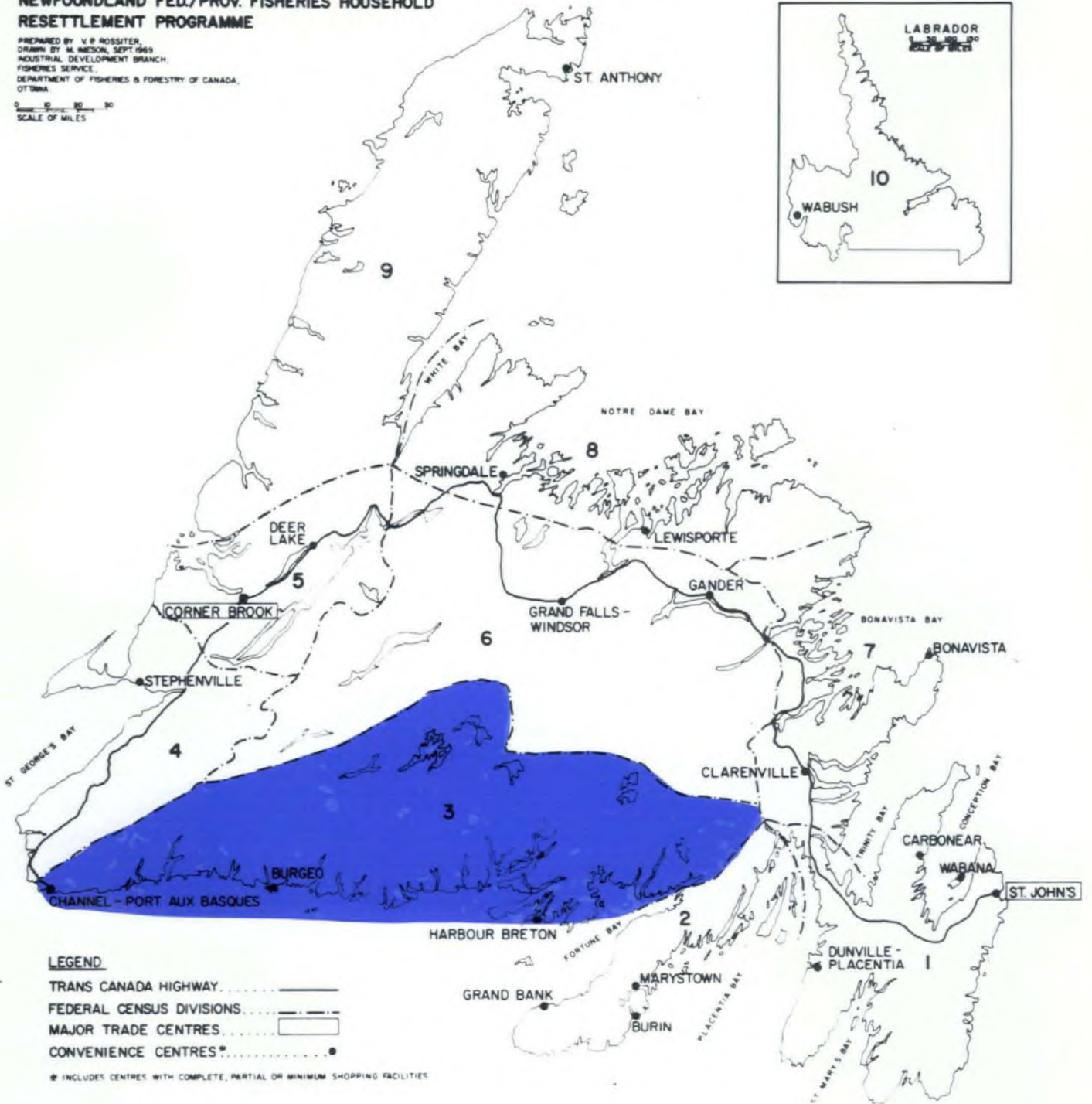

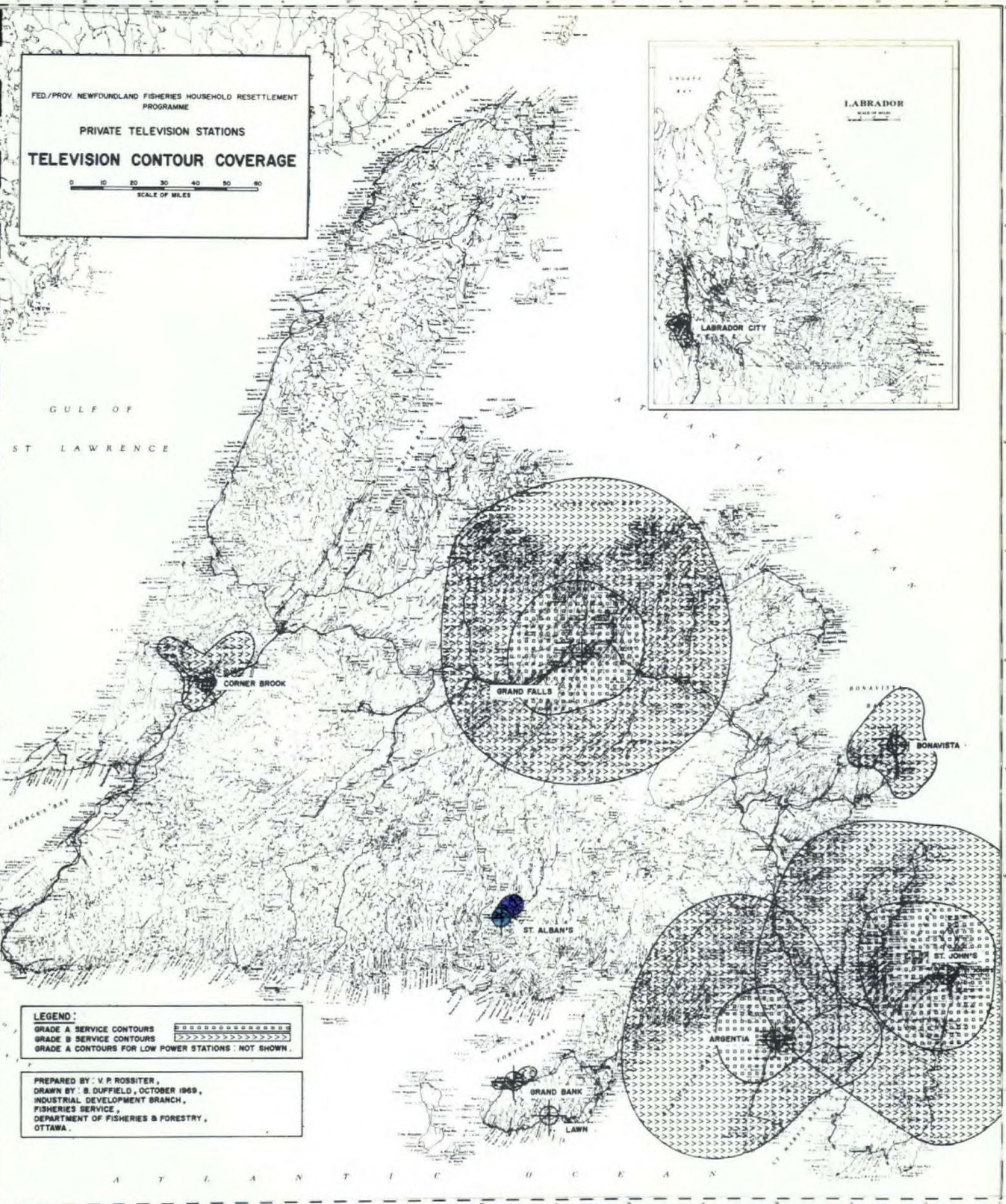


FED./PROV. NEWFOUNDLAND FISHERIES HOUSEHOLD RESETTLEMENT PROGRAMME
