INTRODUCTION

This bibliography of social and economic research pertaining to rural British Columbia is the second revision of a listing prepared initially in 1967 and revised in 1970. The present edition includes materials published to the end of 1970. The bibliography does not include studies dealing solely with Victoria and Vancouver; technical reports related to specific industries such as agriculture, fishing, forestry, and mining; or studies of native Indians unless they pertained to general social and economic conditions in the province.

A total of 314 items are listed compared to 286 in the 1970 edition and 227 in 1967. The items were analyzed by date of publication, and as Table 1 shows, almost one-third of the studies were published between 1966 and 1970 and nearly sixty per cent have been completed within the last ten years. Only one-eighth of those listed were published prior to 1950.

An analysis of the items contained in the bibliography by source of publication is shown in Table 2. Provincial government departments published 27.4 per cent of the items compared to 11.1 per cent for federal and 2.2 per cent for municipal governments. Student theses were the second most frequent source of the studies accounting for 20.7 per cent followed by university publications (17.2 per cent) and journal articles (15.3 per cent).
