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# Contracting Policy Notice 2022-2: Amendments to Appendix D of the Directive on the Management of Procurement Related to the COVID-19 Vaccination of Supplier Personnel

**Subject:** Amendments to Appendix D of the Directive on the Management of Procurement related to the COVID-19 vaccination of supplier personnel

### **Overview**

On June 14, 2022, the Government of Canada announced that the COVID-19 vaccination requirement for public servants is suspended effective June 20, 2022. To align with this change, the <u>Directive on the Management of Procurement</u> is amended to suspend the requirements in Appendix D5 in the section titled COVID-19 Vaccination Policy for Supplier Personnel.

As a result, effective June 20, 2022, departments are no longer required to follow the Public Services and Procurement Canada *COVID-19 Vaccination Policy for Supplier Personnel* and are not required to implement a control framework.
