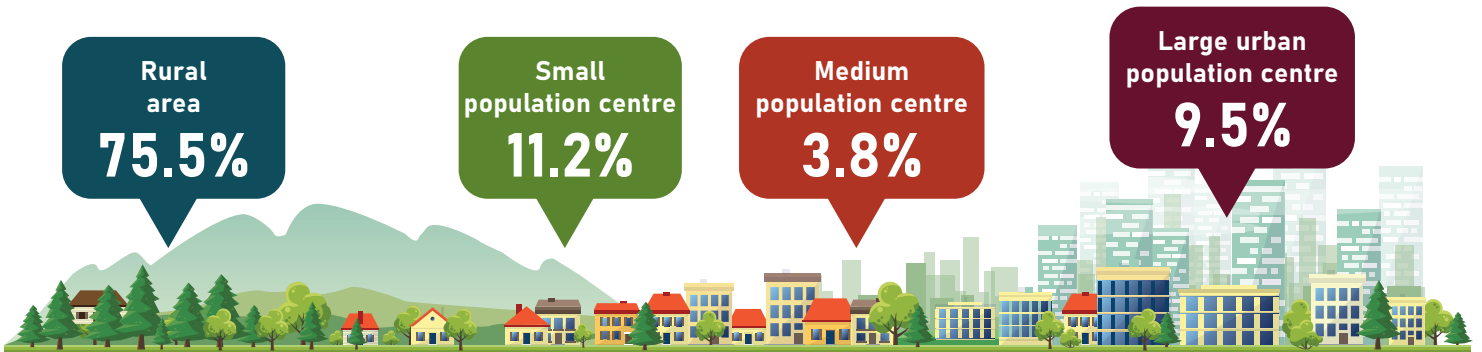

In 1931,

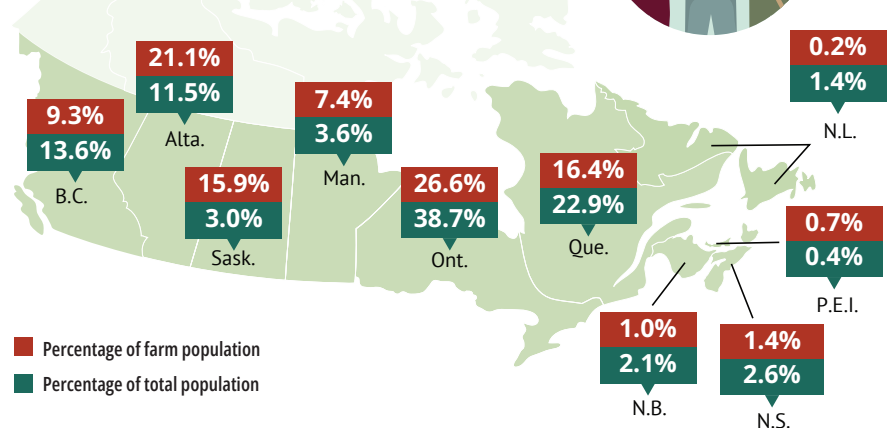
1 in 3 Canadians was a member of the farm population.
