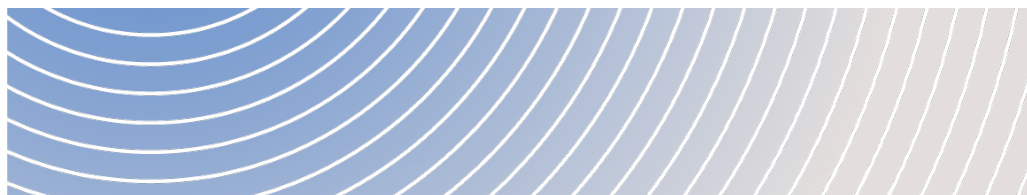

## Significant variance compared with previous fiscal year
