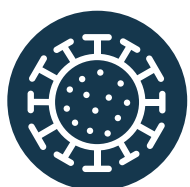
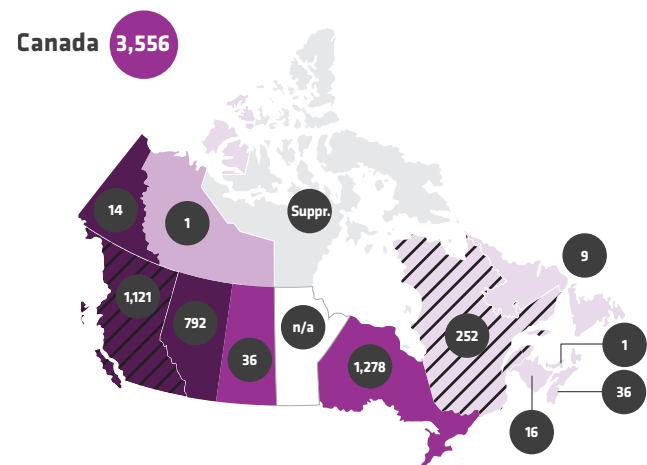


Samples of Health Infobase Data Products
