PREFACE

This bibliography was prepared for the Canadian Wildlife Service by Renewable Resources Consulting Services Ltd. as one part of a contract between the Canadian Wildlife Service and the Saskatchewan-Nelson Basin Board. Under this contract the Canadian Wildlife Service undertook to make a preliminary report on the effects which river regulation and diversion projects could have on Wildlife in the Saskatchewan-Nelson Basin. This, in turn, is one part of a larger study of the feasibility and cost of improving the supply of water to the Prairies being undertaken by the Saskatchewan-Nelson Basin Board.

INTRODUCTION

Planning for future water requirements in the Prairie Provinces has led to various proposals for the development and manipulation of water systems within the Saskatchewan - Nelson basin.

Concomitant with hydrological and engineering research is the need to anticipate and evaluate the ecological ramifications of proposed development programs. An inventory of existing research information pertaining to the basin has been established as a prerequisite to the design of ecological research programs. The following bibliography was compiled to meet the requirement for a systematic catalogue of published and unpublished information relevant to wildlife within the Saskatchewan - Nelson basin area.

Terms of Reference

The main objective of this study was to investigate and document relevant information on wildlife which would be of use to future studies on the effects of water manipulation proposals within the Saskatchewan - Nelson River systems. Under the terms of reference set out for Renewable Resources Consulting Services Ltd. by the Canadian Wildlife Service, the bibliography would include research and reference material pertaining to wildlife habitat and populations as well as studies of land use and water transfers and manipulations affecting economically important wildlife species. For purposes of this study the Saskatchewan - Nelson River basin was defined as that portion of the three prairie provinces south of 54° North latitude.

The study consisted primarily of a search of titles including books, theses, published papers and unpublished reports from 1945 to the present time. Short annotations were to be provided when titles were not sufficiently explanatory of report contents. Thus the bibliography is partially annotated where applicable. Titles were to be grouped into different parts, serially numbered and cross - referenced by author.

Sources of Information

Several methods of investigation were carried out to obtain a list of references. Investigations included searches of selected bibliographic catalogues; direct interviews and contacts with private and public agencies. Organization and Format

The information gathered has been classified under one of the following three categories:

Part I. - "Land use studies with implications for economically important wildlife in the Saskatchewan - Nelson River Basin."

Part II. - "Habitat and populations of wildlife within the basin."

Part III. - "The effect of water flows and levels on wildlife habitat within the Saskatchewan - Nelson Basin and other areas in North America."

Information in each of the three parts was further separated by location into "Alberta", "Saskatchewan", "Manitoba" and "General". Part IV contains additional information pertaining

to "Sedimentation" and other "Bibliographies". Part V consists of the "Author Cross - Reference Index".

All reports classified under the four parts are serially numbered. For each reference, the following information is provided:

- 1.) Serial number
- 2.) Author
- 3.) Date of report
- 4.) Name of report
- 5.) Agency representing the report.
- 6.) Number of pages (when available).
- 7.) Annotation (when required and report was available).
- 8.) Source of report (if other than at the agency representing the report), usually the abbreviation in last bracket.

Titles are arranged alphabetically under each sub-heading. In cases where the same author has more than one title under the same heading, titles were sorted by year of completion.

Titles have been cross-referenced by author and serial number in a separate index. Therefore, all reports by an author in the bibliography, can be readily located in the authors index. The authors index is also in alphabetical order.
