

101.13 CWS-AR Boyer 1949 During the banding operation I ekpt a daily record of the birds seen in the vicinity of Port Mouton and Port Joli. Dr.H.F. Tufts of Riverhead, Port Mouton, one of the foremost ornithologists of Nova Scotia, informed me that this year the population of normal winter residents was very much below usual. He believes that the severe winter of 1947 - 48 took a heavy toll of such birds as Robins, Song Sparrows, Juncos, Myrtle Warblers etc, and that this accounted for the small numbers to be seen this year.
