Report by Asiley, G.H.W.

This report is in further reference to the reports made in 1944 and 1947, by H. U. Green.

Numerous changes have been made as to the distribution and status of the beaver in the area since the last investigation was conducted. These changes were brought about mainly through the environmental factors of food supply and interference of man.

The area covered by this investigation is the Bow Valley from the East Gate to Hillsdale. This terrain corresponds to wild-life research areas No. 1 and 2 as explained in the 1947 reports on the beaver of the valley involved. To enable comparison between the sites as they are at present and as they were at the time of the 1947 report the same site numbers are used. Additive sites are given new numbers.

The research areas to be considered are:

East Cate to Banff including Two Jacks and Johnson Lakes area.

Banff to Hillsdale. Area No. 2.

The following material is the portinent data derived, considered by areas, together with summary, abstract and map. Mapped sites outlined in red are live sites; those outlined in blue are abandoned.
