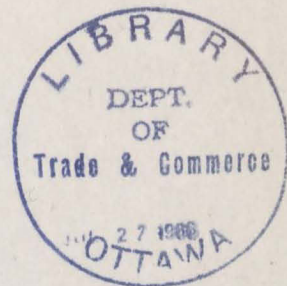

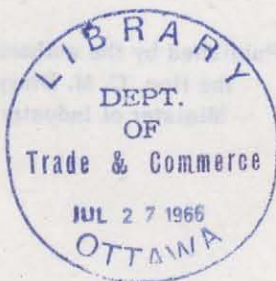

INTRODUCTION

Expansion of the market for chemicals and related products creates numerous opportunities for establishing new manufacturing operations as well as for expanding existing productions. To determine the growth trends in the market and its attendant opportunities, an analysis has been made of imports of chemicals, petroleum and rubber products during the period from 1956 to 1964. The results of the analysis are published for the purpose of helping industry to identify opportunities for efficient manufacturing operations in Canada.

In 1964 imports of chemical, petroleum and rubber products had a total value of approximately \$970 million. Of the total, chemicals and chemical products accounted for \$455 million, crude petroleum and petroleum and coal products for \$441 million and rubber products \$74 million. The corresponding total for these categories in 1956 was \$781 million and a preliminary estimate for 1965 shows a total of \$1070 million.

In addition to publishing the results of this survey, the Department of Industry stands ready to provide additional information on these opportunities. Enquiries relating to any aspect of this report should be directed to the Chemicals Branch.

EXPLANATORY NOTES

The basis of this report is a consolidation of data previously published in "Chemical Import Trends, a Five Year Study" which covered the period from 1956 to 1960, and in its supplements for the years 1961, 1962 and 1963. To this has been added pertinent data from "Trade of Canada, Imports 1964" and data for a number of chemical, petroleum and rubber commodities not previously included in "Chemical Import Trends" or its supplements.

Consideration has also been given to the changes which occurred in import statistics in January 1964 when Dominion Bureau of Statistics commenced publishing data on the basis of revised Import Commodity Classifications. In the report, the former class numbers are shown for data in the years from 1956 to 1963 and the new class numbers for the year 1964. The report thus serves as a key for translating between the old and new classes.

Values for commodities marked with an asterisk (*) have been estimated from the Dominion Bureau of Statistics' tabulation of \$1,000 entries of "n.e.s." classes, for the years 1956 to 1963. All values for 1964 are actual figures reported by "Trade of Canada, Imports 1964".

A cross-reference index is included to assist in locating commodities listed under group headings or included with other products.

The D.B.S. class number and Customs Tariff item number are indicated as references for each product. Where more than one class and tariff item are shown, these are listed independently of one another in numerical sequence. In cases where tariff items are too numerous to be conveniently listed, the word "Various" has been shown.

The following symbols and abbreviations are used:

in year indicated.
- n.e.s. - Not elsewhere specified.
- ∅ - Class discontinued or revised.
- ... - Figure not available.
- ... - Figure too small.

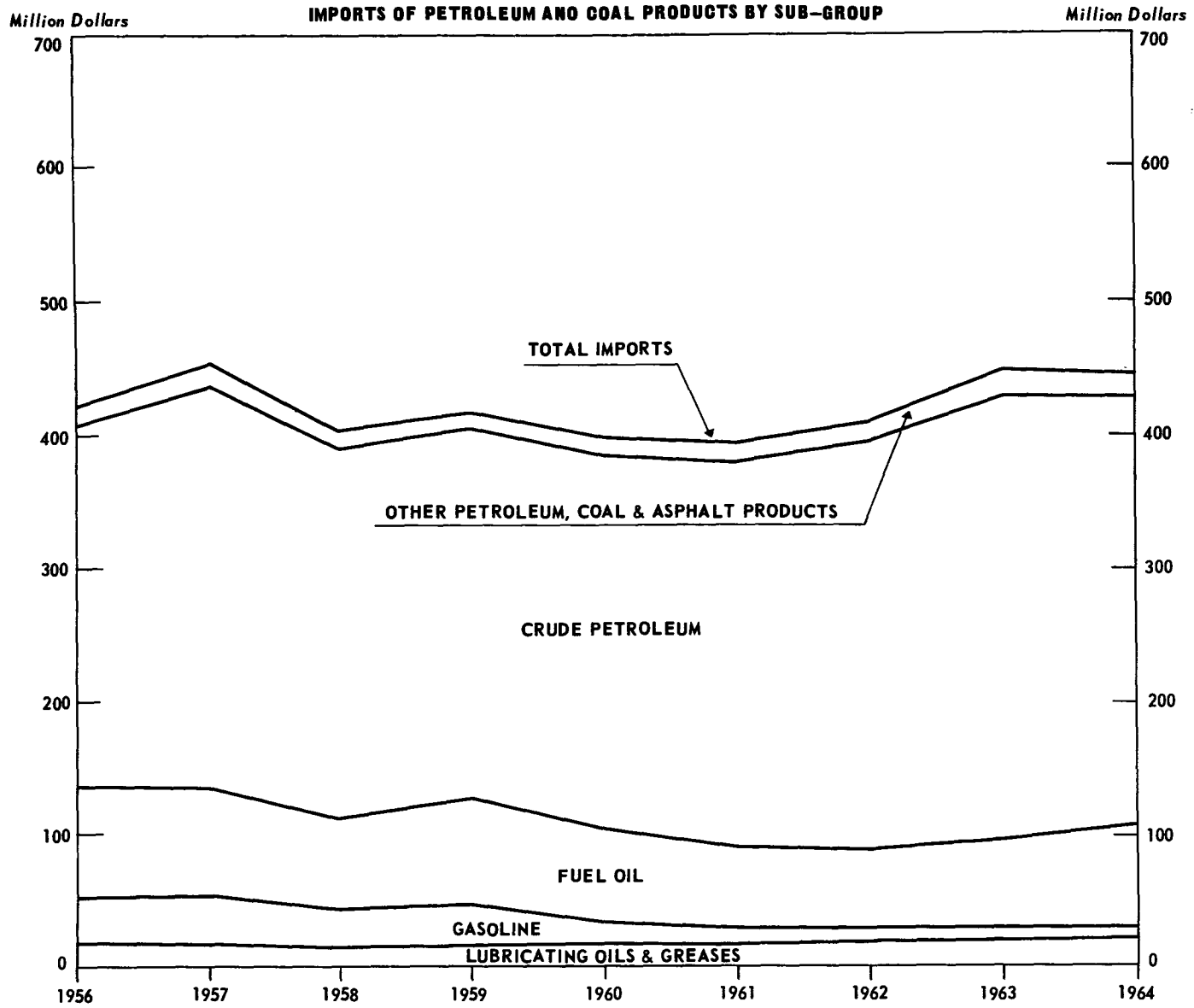

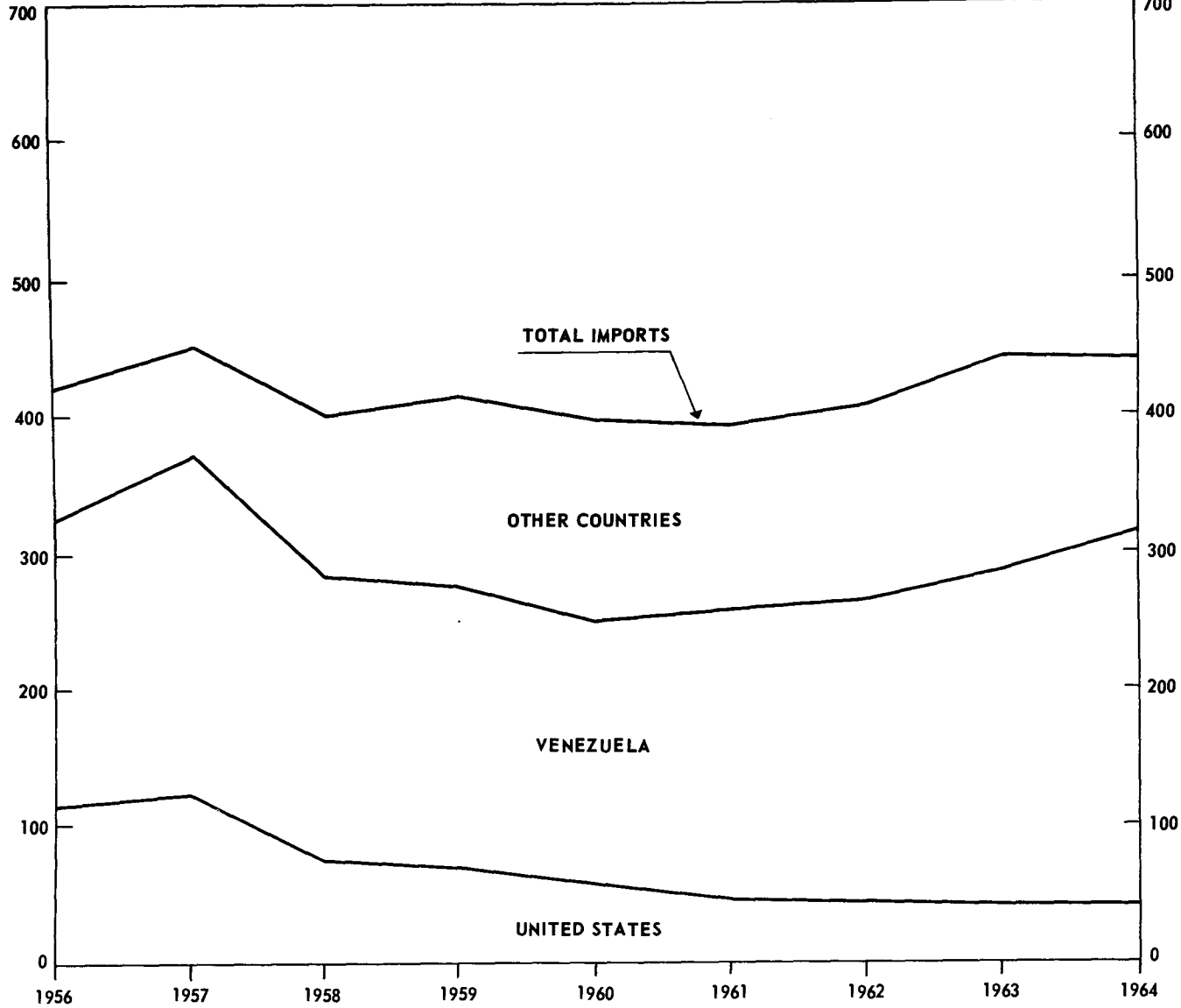

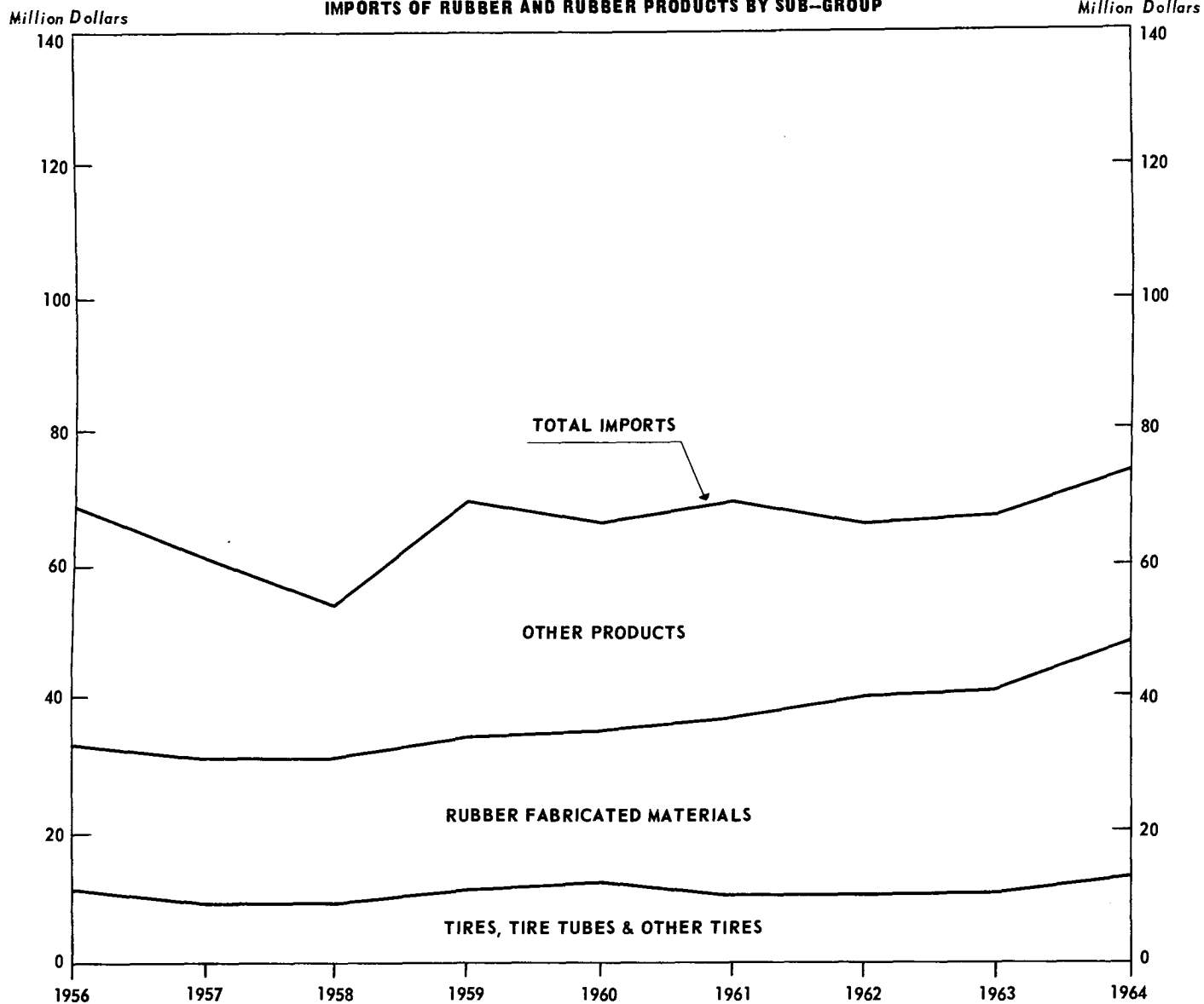

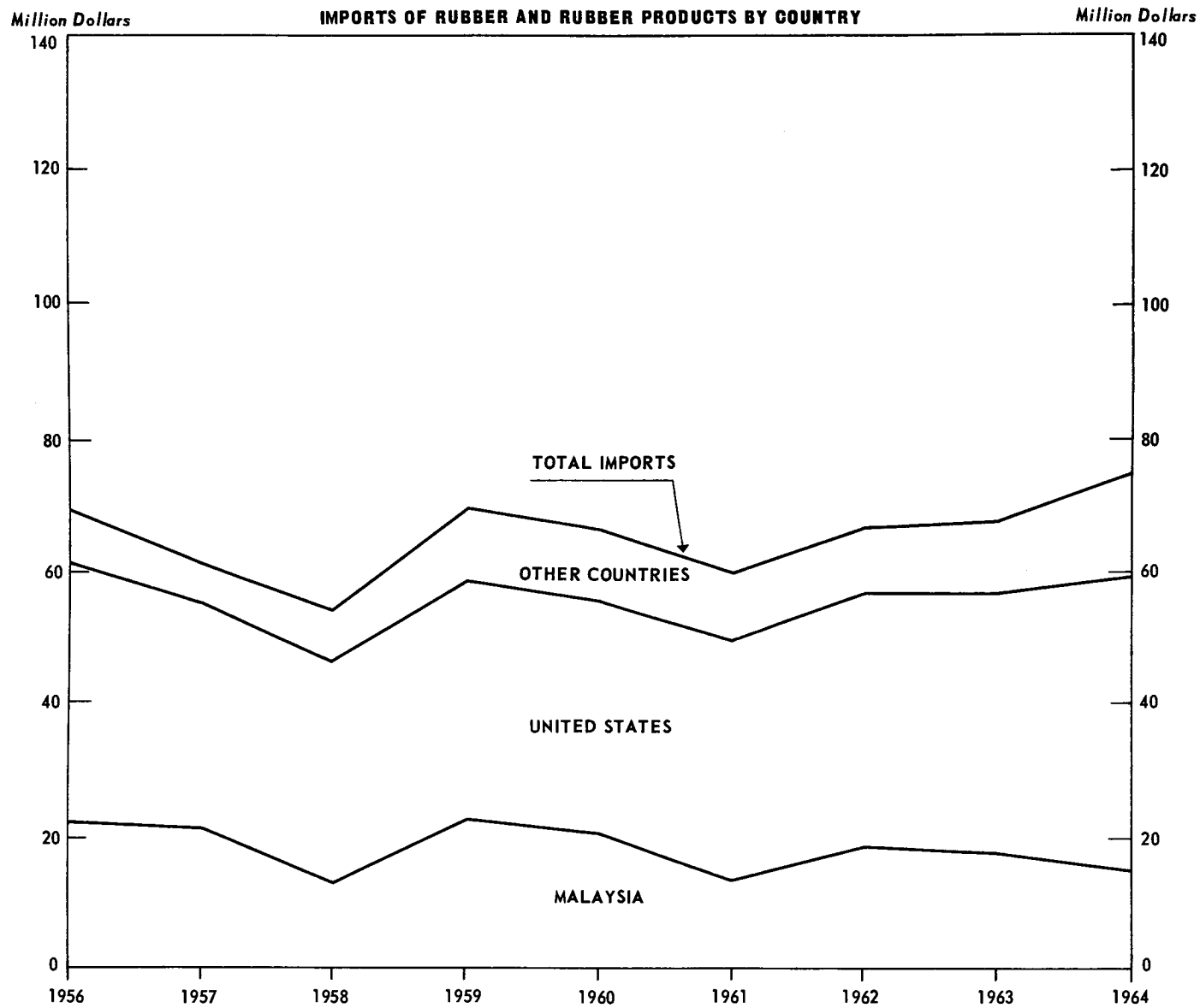
IMPORTS OF RUBBER AND RUBBER PRODUCTS BY SUB-GROUP
