INTRODUCTION

This document has been designed as a ready reference to the statistical performance of the Canadian electronics industry. Based upon Statistics Canada information, it provides detailed production, trade and employment information for 1984 as well as trends since 1964. Highlighted are the key markets for Canadian electronic products as well as the countries that are major suppliers to Canada, although not part of the electronics industry. Similar coverage is provided for the small and major appliance sectors.

The Electronics and Aerospace Branch and its predecessors have been publishing this document on an annual basis since 1964 as a service to firms in the industry and analysts inside and outside government who are interested in the development and growth of this dynamic sector. We are most interested in ensuring that the document is useful to its readers and would welcome any comments regarding improvements in content and format.

PERFORMANCE OF THE
ELECTRONICS INDUSTRY & HOUSEHOLD ELECTRICAL APPLIANCES

INDUSTRY HIGHLIGHTS

Electronics

Canadian demand for electronics products in 1984 was sharply higher than in 1982 and 1983. The apparent domestic market rose by 28 per cent from just over \$9 billion in 1983 to almost \$12 billion in 1984. While this resurgence for the year was very impressive, most of the strength came in the early quarters and thereafter growth was definitely on a downward path. In our view some further earnings of the Canadian market are likely in 1985.

At the peak in the second quarter, the domestic market was 39 per cent higher than in the corresponding prior quarter. But growth was only 17 per cent by the fourth quarter as the resurgence in demand was quickly running out of steam..

Leading the robust performance of the industry were the office machines and radio and television sectors with growth rates of 46 per cent and 33 per cent respectively. Demand in the home market for products of the communications and components and instruments sectors was lackluster by comparison.

The increased domestic market demand in 1984 was satisfied more by foreign manufacturers than Canadian. The market rise of \$2.6 billion was less than the increase of imports which rose by \$3 billion. Thus home manufacturers actually gave up market share to the extent of \$400 million. At the end of the year Canadian producers had achieved just a 14 per cent share of the domestic market.

Canada's exports performance, was however rather better. Annual growth for exports was 41 per cent and on a level with that of imports. However, fourth quarter growth for exports was also 41 per cent, whereas, import growth dropped to 26 per cent as the domestic demand slackened.

Overall however Canadian performance was disappointing. The unfavourable balance-of-trade in 1984 reached \$5 308 million, up sharply from \$3 716 million in 1983.

The relative performance of the telecommunication and computer and office machine sectors is significant. Back in 1979 when the industry's trade deficit stood at a relatively low \$1 989 million, computers and office machines accounted for \$720 million and communications and components accounted for \$590 million. By 1984, the computer and office machine trade deficit had mushroomed to \$3 060 million while that of communication and components had contracted to \$443 million. With the unfavourable trade balance of the industry so tied to the performance in office machines, the latter sector's trade deficit increased over \$1 billion (53 per cent) in the past year and is cause for concern. If there is a bright spot in the industry, it is the communications and components sector. Not only is its annual trade deficit on a downward trend, the sector actually returned a trade surplus in the final quarter of 1984.

The road to that surplus is mapped out below.


As appears, the final quarter's surplus in telephone equipment was very strong and quite exceptional in commercial communication equipment. What the future holds here will depend, in the former, on continuing the high level of exports to the United States (\$181 million in the final quarter and up from \$128 million in the third quarter); and, in the latter, on exports to Brazil. Exports to Brazil in the fourth quarter were \$80 million or 87 per cent of the year's total and higher than exports to the United States for the quarter.

HOUSEHOLD APPLIANCES


The domestic market for major appliances was not nearly as strong as in 1983. Expansion in 1984 was 6 per cent versus 20 per cent in the prior year. Although Canadian demand slackened, imports added \$65 million more to the home market to take up all of the 6 per cent market growth to the exclusion of Canadian shipments.

Home demand for small appliances was stronger than in 1983 in contrast to major appliances. This allowed Canadian shipments to expand by contributing to the improved home market and by increasing exports.


1984 ELECTRONICS INDUSTRY AND HHLD. ELEC.APPLIANCES




1983 ELECTRONICS INDUSTRY AND HHLD. ELEC. APPLIANCES




1984 ELECTRONICS INDUSTRY SHIPMENTS
BY S.I.C. SUB-SECTORS




1979 ELECTRONICS INDUSTRY SHIPMENTS
BY S.I.C. SUB-SECTORS




1984 ELECTRONICS INDUSTRY IMPORTS BY S.I.C. SUB-SECTORS




1979 ELECTRONICS INDUSTRY IMPORTS BY S.I.C. SUB-SECTORS




1984 ELECTRONICS INDUSTRY EXPORTS BY S.I.C. SUB-SECTORS




1979 ELECTRONICS INDUSTRY EXPORTS BY S.I.C. SUB-SECTORS
