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

INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

This report is one of a continuing series designed to increase business awareness of the potential existing for domestic production and to stimulate Canadian business to further explore potential opportunities in both the Canadian and export markets. It is important to emphasize that this report does not attempt any assessment as to the feasibility of manufacturing or competing in a particular market and should be treated as an indicator or starting point for the manufacturer or entrepreneur.

This report covers imports of metal hardware for windows, not elsewhere specified, classified to Commodity Code 465-69-69 of the Canadian International Trade Classification (C.I.T.C.). This import commodity class includes casement adjusters and fittings; sash fasteners, rollers, pulleys, etc. Although not included in this report, plastic hardware for windows is included in C.I.T.C. code 425-99-69.

IMPORT TRENDS: OVERVIEW



Imports of metal hardware for windows, not elsewhere specified, were approximately \$12 million in 1983 and 1984 and increased to \$17 million in 1985.

During 1985, the value of imports totalled \$17.1 million, an increase of 43 per cent from 1984, and three times the 1982 import value.

The United States has consistently been the major exporter to Canada, accounting for 97 per cent of the total import value in 1982, 1983 and 1984 then down to 90 per cent in 1985.

The top 10 importers accounted for 53 per cent of the total imports for 1984. All were manufacturers. Four of these importers were situated in Ontario and four in Québec.

There were at least 280 known importers during 1984. The top 20 importers accounted for \$7.7 million, or 65 per cent of the total import value. Nineteen of these importers were manufacturers, representing 64 per cent of the import total. Of these, 13 were millwork manufacturers representing \$5.8 million or 49 per cent of the 1984 import total.

CANADIAN PRODUCTION

At least six companies manufacture metal hardware for windows. Statistics Canada does not report shipments of window hardware separately, but does report that shipments of door and window hardware, not elsewhere specified (including metal knobs and handles) were \$12 million in 1983, the latest year for which information is available.

EXPORTS

Statistics Canada does not report on exports of metal hardware for windows. These are included in "Basic Hardware, not elsewhere specified," which had exports valued at \$102.8 million in 1985.

MARKET SUMMARY

Imports of window hardware into Canada have shown a significant increase since 1982. This increase is due to a significant change from sliding to casement windows. Casement windows require entirely different hardware from that used on sliding windows, and there is no manufacturing of casement window hardware in Canada. Canadian companies do manufacture hardware for sliding windows, particularly of aluminum, for which almost all hardware is Canadian made.

Casement window operators enter Canada on a duty-remitted basis and will continue to do so until the manufacture of equipment operators is started in Canada. Such operators are bought directly from foreign manufacturers by individual Canadian window manufacturers. The dominant source of operators is Truth Inc. of Minnesota, U.S.A.

A potential manufacturer of window hardware in Canada should plan on providing casement operators and on supplying of a full line of complementary window hardware (such as concealed hinges, extension bars, window and sash locks). The products would have to be of good quality, and sell at competitive prices: duty remission adjustments would help.

Such an undertaking would have little difficulty in identifying potential customers in Canada. Possibly arrangements could be made to draw on the knowledge of domestic markets held by present Canadian manufactures, in combination with the skills and international market access of foreign manufacturers.
