Figures may not add due to rounding.

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

INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

This report is one of a continuing series designed to increase business awareness of the potential existing for domestic production and to stimulate Canadian business to further explore potential opportunities in both the Canadian and export markets. It is important to emphasize that this report does not attempt any assessment as to the feasibility of manufacturing or competing in a particular market and should be treated as an indicator or starting point for the manufacturer or entrepreneur.

This report covers imports of Aluminum Household Cooking Utensils (Canadian International Trade Classification (C.I.T.C.) code 850-07-20). This import commodity code consists of pots and pans, pie plates, pressure cookers, tea kettles and coffee pots (excluding electric).

IMPORT TRENDS: OVERVIEW



Between 1982 and 1983, imports of aluminum household cooking utensils increased sharply from \$13.1 million to \$21.3 million. From 1983 to 1985, they declined to \$17.2 million.

Imports of aluminum household cooking utensils totalled \$17.2 million in 1985, a decrease of 17 per cent from 1984.

Much of the 1982-1983 increase was due to an aggressive entry into the North American market by a Hong Kong supplier.

From 1983, exports from the United States, Hong Kong and France accounted together for 75 to 79 per cent of Canadian imports. The United States' share of Canadian imports in those years was 26 to 29 per cent, while the individual share of the other two countries was in the 20 to 30 per cent range.

France has exported to Canada approximately the same value of cooking utensils since 1983, while the exports of the United States and Hong Kong have decreased significantly.

The 10 top importers accounted for \$12.2 million or 59 per cent of the total imports for 1984. They were all wholesalers. Five were situated in Ontario and five in Québec.

There were at least 346 known importers of aluminum cooking utensils during 1984. The top 30 importers accounted for \$17 million or 82 per cent of the total import value. Of these companies, five were department stores with imports representing \$2.4 million or 11 per cent of the import total, and eight were wholesalers of home furnishings, which accounted for \$7 million or 34 per cent of the import total.

CANADIAN: PRODUCTION 7.

There were at least five Canadian manufacturers of aluminum household cooking utensils. Statistics Canada does not provide specific production data on these utensils.

EXPORTS

Statistics Canada does not provide specific data on exports of aluminum household cooking utensils. They are included in the group "Kitchen Utensils and Parts, Not Elsewhere Specified," which had exports valued at \$9.6 million in 1985.

MARKET SUMMARY

The market for domestic cookware in Canada has traditionally been divided between aluminum and stainless steel utensils. Historically, aluminum cookware has predominated in terms of both domestic production and imported product.

Cookware competes with other products in the houseware market which is one of the fastest changing product sectors, with short product life cycles constantly creating the need for new and improved products. Moreover, cookware competes for the consumer's interest with fairly standard lines that have changed little in recent years, against a dynamic availability of other houseware product options.

While the metal cookware industry is not subject to highly seasonal market fluctuations, industry sources report a double production "surge" between January to February and September to October, with approximately 40 per cent of shipments made in the first half of the year, and 60 per cent in the second half. The major retail promotions for housewares occur in the March-April and October-November periods.

The cookware industry markets its products through retail and wholesale channels and through direct selling, that is, through the "party plan" method or through mail order catalogue sales. Exclusive products are developed for direct sale merchandising. Because it is less competitive than selling through retail channels, manufacturers can operate with much higher profit margins, while targeting their marketing approach to the more specialized high-end or specialty gournet market. However, the vast proportion of cookware is still marketed via company representatives across the country to hardware and department stores, wholesalers, mass merchandisers and supermarkets.

Imports from Western Europe (mainly from France, Italy and Spain) have traditionally been high quality products, appealing to the affluent consumer who was looking for top performance and modern design features. Such names as Lagostina (Italy), Magefesa (Spain), Le Creuset and Cuisinox (France) have become easily identified in the marketplace for those characteristics.

At the other end of the market spectrum, imports of cookware from South East Asia have represented the low-end in terms of both quality and price, and were distributed by bargain mass merchandisers and supermarket outlets. In recent years, however, there has been a significant upgrading of production standards in the manufacture of medium to high-end cookware products, particularly in Hong Kong and the Republic of Korea. These new competitively-priced imports are now entering the North American market which is increasingly price and quality sensitive, and competing against the traditional Canadian production strengths in medium to high-end cookware. The aluminum cookware market has been particularly affected by this trend.

Since 1980, imports have represented between 45 and 55 per cent of the domestic cookware market in Canada. The last three years have shown a gradual increase in the share of the market supplied by imports, while at the same time, exports of Canadian manufactured cookware have also increased to approximately 25 per cent of domestic production.

Market demand for cookware products should increase in the top-of-the-line segment of the market (both aluminum and stainless steel), thereby providing Canadian manufacturers with opportunities to expand and develop new design features in their products.

Moreover, Canadian producers should be able to take advantage of growth potential in other specific markets. While Canadian manufacturers do not enjoy the economies of scaler resulting from the long production runs of their United States competitors, most Canadian producers have been able to make their smaller size a strength rather than a weakness insofar as shorter production runs afford them greater manufacturing flexibility. This type of manufacturing flexibility has, in the past, allowed Canadian producers to meet the specific needs of export markets, such as Japan, Singapore, Malaysia, and the U.S.A.

Competition is fierce in the multi-product houseware sector, and Canadian cookware manufacturers have to establish a high profile to compete for consumer interest against the internationally-known name brands from the United States and Western Europe. A stronger consumer identification base would benefit the Canadian industry in both the domestic market and on the international scene.

The Canadian Most Favoured Nation (MFN) tariff on both aluminum and stainless steel cookware in 1986 is 11.1 per cent (10.2 per cent in 1987). The United States tariffs are between 3.6 and 6 per cent.
