

INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

This report is one of a continuing series designed to increase business awareness of the potential existing for domestic production and to stimulate Canadian business to further explore potential opportunities in both the Canadian and export markets. It is important to emphasize that this report does not attempt any assessment as to the feasibility of manufacturing or competing in a particular market and should be treated as an indicator or starting point for the manufacturer or entrepreneur.

This report examines polyester film, 0.01 inches or less in thickness (Canadian International Trade Classification class 424-13-20), including melinex, mylar and scotchpar film. Polyester film is used primarily in the manufacture of food packaging, magnetic tapes, and X-ray and photographic film.

IMPORT TRENDS: OVERVIEW



Between 1982 and 1985, the value of imports of polyester film grew significantly. The value of imports increased from \$36.3 million in 1982 to \$60.0 million in 1984. However, it decreased to \$53.8 million in 1985. During the first 10 months of 1986, imports totalled \$40.2 million, a decrease of 8.6 per cent from the first 10 months of 1985.

The quantity of imports of polyester film followed a similar trend to that of the value. During the period January to October 1986, imports totalled 6 100 tonnes, a decrease of 9.1 per cent from the same period in 1985.


The United States was the leading exporter to Canada of polyester film. Throughout the four-year period, it had at least 89 per cent of the value of Canadian imports. In 1985, its exports amounted to \$47.7 million, or 88.6 per cent of the total. Japan was a distant second ranking exporter to Canada with only \$1.8 million, or 3.4 per cent of Canadian imports. In 1986, the United Kingdom displaced France as the third largest exporter to Canada.

During the period under study, the average unit price of imports of polyester film remained fairly stable, fluctuating between \$7 000 and \$8 000 per metric tonne. However, unit prices of imports from the Republic of Korea and France were considerably lower than those of the other major countries of export to Canada.

IMPORTS BY PROVINCE OF CLEARANCE



In 1985, the principal province of clearance for imports of polyester film was Ontario. This province accounted for 5 701 tonnes, or 73.7 per cent of the total import quantity. The next ranking province of entry was Québec, with 1 121 tonnes, or 14.5 per cent of the total. The remaining provinces accounted for 917 tonnes, or 11.8 per cent of total imports.

In terms of value, Ontario accounted for \$41.9 million, or 77.8 per cent of the import total, followed by Québec (\$5.5 million, or 10.2 per cent), Manitoba (\$3.6 million, or 6.6 per cent), and the remaining provinces (\$2.9 million, or 5.4 per cent).

In 1985, the 10 major importers accounted for \$35.7 million, or 66 per cent of the value of imports of polyester film. Seven of the ten major importers were manufacturers of diverse products, and two were wholesalers. Seven of the top ten importers were located in Ontario.

In 1985, there were 379 known importers of polyester film. The top 20 importers accounted for \$41.7 million, or 77 per cent of the total value of imports. Ten of the top 20 importers were manufacturers of a variety of products, whose imports represented \$32.9 million, or 61 per cent of the total.

UNITED STATES' IMPORTS

The United States Department of Commerce indicates that in 1985, United States' imports of polyester film, strips and sheets totalled 23 322 tonnes with a value of C\$141 million. Japan was the principal country of export to the U.S. with C\$91.1 million, or 64 per cent, of the total value of imports, and 14 915 tonnes, or 64 per cent, of the total import quantity. CANADIAN PRODUCTION

Polyester film is not manufactured in Canada.

MARKET SUMMARY

Polyester film (also known as polyester terephthalate, or P.E.T. film) is used to manufacture products such as food packaging, magnetic tapes, X-ray and photographic film, and wire wrap in cable construction.

Specific physical properties can be built into the film during the manufacturing operation depending on the end use to which it will be put, and it can be decorated by printing or metallizing.

Polyester films are not manufactured in Canada. Some of the imported film is re-exported in finished products of which the film forms a major component. These include food packaging films, wire cable components, and magnetic tapes.

As previously indicated in this report, imports of polyester film in bulk form, in 1985, amounted to about 7 700 tonnes valued at \$54 million. Potential manufacturers of polyester film should note that, in addition, imports of blank video tapes, made of polyester film, during the same period, were valued at \$108 million. The film is imported for resale by Canadian subsidiaries or agents of foreign based multinational enterprises. Blank video tapes are imported in a similar manner, although some volume purchasing groups in Canada are large enough to buy directly from foreign manufacturers.

If a manufacturing entity for bulk film were to be established in Canada, it would be essential that manufacturing technology be obtained either by licensing arrangements or by direct purchase in order to minimize very costly research and development and start-up expenses. As the basic polymer resin is not made in Canada, a reliable source of supply would have to be located.

The large domestic market and the possibility of developing export sales, would appear to represent a significant opportunity for a Canadian-based manufacturer of polyester film.
