## CANADIAN MARKET OPPORTUNITIES - IMPORT PROFILE

#### PORTABLE COMPRESSORS

#### INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

This report is one of a continuing series designed to increase business awareness of the potential existing for domestic production and to stimulate Canadian business to further explore potential opportunities in both the Canadian and export markets. It is important to emphasize that this report does not attempt any assessment as to the feasibility of manufacturing or competing in a particular market and should be treated as an indicator or starting point for the manufacturer or entrepreneur.

Portable compressors, covered in this report, are classified to Import Commodity Classification (M.C.C.) Code 507-29. This code is subdivided into the following 12 Canadian International Trade Classification (C.I.T.C.) Codes. Tables in this report aggregate data for the 12 classes of products. Portable compressors are used mainly in the construction industry. Data for stationary air and gas compressors, and parts and accessories are included in profile numbers 84-87 and 86-87.



#### IMPORT TRENDS: OVERVIEW

#### PORTABLE COMPRESSORS



Between 1982 and 1985, the value of imports of portable compressors rose at an average annual rate of 24 per cent. In the first two years of that period, the value of imports was steady, averaging \$13.3 million. However, in the last two years of the period, it experienced significant growth; it increased to \$19.6 million in 1984, and to \$24.6 million in 1985. Data for the first nine months of 1986, indicates a further large increase.

Between 1982 and 1983, the quantity of imports declined from 58 273 units to 36 798 units. However, in the last two years of the period analysed, imports increased dramatically. In analysing this data, it should be noted that the range of products within individual groups are broad, including individual products of small value, high volume as well as high value, low volume. As a result, aggregate data shows large fluctuations from year to year, and from one category to another. Nevertheless, the data as presented, gives an overview of the sector while showing areas for potentially more detailed examination.


Between 1982 and 1985, in terms of value, the United States was the largest exporter to Canada of portable compressors. For each of the four years, it had at least 83 per cent of the Canadian import market. In 1985, it supplied \$21.5 million worth of portable compressors. In 1982, high volumes of imports were recorded from Hong Kong and Singapore which are included in "other countries". However, in 1985, there were no imports from these countries.

During the first nine months of 1986, 85 per cent of the import value of portable compressors originated from the U.S.A. The remaining Canadian imports originated primarily from Belgium, Luxembourg and Italy.

The average unit price for portable compressors varied considerably during the four year period. The variation in unit price is due to the heterogeneity of the products (see page 8).

#### PORTABLE COMPRESSORS

In 1985, the product category with the highest share of imports was portable compressors 10 CFM and under. During this period, this category represented 60 per cent of the quantity and 17 per cent of the value of imports of portable compressors. The next ranked category was portable compressors 60 CFM to 99 CFM which accounted for 14 per cent of the quantity and 13 per cent of the value of imports followed by portable compressors, 11 CFM to 59 CFM, which accounted for 14 per cent and 12 per cent respectively. Imports of portable compressors 100 CFM and over accounted for 4 146 units (7 per cent) and \$10.2 million (41 per cent). Package Units and Other accounted for 3 644 units (6 per cent) or \$4.1 million (17 per cent) of imports of portable compressors during 1985.

In 1985, in terms of quantity and value, the United States was the major exporter to Canada in every category of imports of portable compressors.

## IMPORTS BY PROVINCE OF CLEARANCE - 1985




In 1985, the bulk of the volume of imports of portable compressors were cleared through five provinces. The five provinces accounted for 61 091 units or 96 per cent of the total imports cleared into Canada.

Ontario had the major share with 35 313 units or 56 per cent of total imports. Manitoba was second with 8 689 units or 14 per cent. Third, was British Columbia with 6 588 units or 10 per cent. Québec was fourth, with 5 796 or nine per cent, followed by Alberta with 4 705 units or seven per cent.

In 1985, by value, imports of portable compressors were primarily cleared through five provinces. The five provinces accounted for \$23.1 million or 94 per cent of the total value.

Ontario was the main province of clearance in terms of value with \$11.3 million, or 46 per cent of total imports. It was followed by Québec with \$4.1 million, or 17 per cent; Alberta with \$3.1 million or 13 per cent; British Columbia with \$2.8 million or 11 per cent; and Manitoba with \$1.9 million or 8 per cent. The other provinces' imports totalled \$1.5 million, or four per cent.

In 1985, the 10 major importers of portable compressors accounted for \$10.8 million, or 44 per cent of the total imports. Six of the ten major importers are wholesalers, accounting for \$5.8 million or 24 per cent of imports. Of the top 10 importers, five companies were located in Ontario, four in Québec and one in the Western Provinces.

NOTE: "Top importers" are the known importers with the largest imports by value in 1985.

In 1985, there were at least 435 importers of portable compressors. The top 40 importers accounted for \$17.3 million, or 70 per cent of the value of imports. Twenty-two of the top 40 importers were wholesalers, which represented \$9.2 million or 37 per cent of the value of imports. Thirteen of these 22 importers were wholesalers of industrial, construction and mining machinery and equipment, which accounted for \$6.4 million of the imports of portable compressors. Eleven of the top 40 importers were manufacturers, which represented \$4.7 million or 19 per cent of the value of imports. Five of these 11 importers were manufacturers of compressors or of mining machinery and equipment, and accounted for \$3.8 million of imports of portable compressors.

#### UNITED STATES IMPORTS

The United States Department of Commerce indicates U.S. imports of all stationary and portable compressors and parts from all countries totalled C\$353.5 million in 1985. Of this amount, portable air compressors totalled at least C\$22.0 million, Canadian exports accounting for at least C\$1.1 million. For further details see Appendix B, page 15.

#### CANADIAN PRODUCTION

There are at least three manufacturers of wheel or skid mounted portable compressor sets in Canada. Statistics Canada does not publish separate information on the manufacture of portable compressors.

#### **CANADIAN EXPORTS**

In 1986, Statistics Canada reported that exports of stationary and portable compressors accounted for 2 466 units, or \$3.6 million. Air compressors accounted for 2 418 units, valued at \$2.2 million; gas compressors accounted for 48 units valued at \$1.4 million. Parts for the stationary and portable compressors totalled \$8.1 million in 1986. This does not include all compressors as other types are included in export codes that do not show separate data for compressors (e.g. 655-99 Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Equipment and Parts, Not Elsewhere Specified).

#### DEPARTMENT OF SUPPLY AND SERVICES PROCUREMENTS

The Department of Supply and Services reports that the federal government purchased \$5.2 million worth of stationary and portable compressors during the period April 1985 to March 1986. This value includes acquisitions, repair and maintenance.

NOTE: This figure is for purchases by the Department of Supply and Services only, and may not include direct purchases by other federal government departments.

#### MARKET SUMMARY

This profile deals specifically with portable compressors. Data for the stationary type and parts for both stationary and portable types are included in profile numbers 84-87 and 86-87. The range of products covered in these three profiles includes standard plant air compressor, engine driven portables, oil and gas field production, process and pipeline service compressors and sets. Also included are a wide range of miscellaneous compressors and sets for such diverse end uses as artists' air brushes, scuba diving, etc.

In 1984, the domestic market for all types of compressors and parts was estimated at \$206 million, with domestic shipments of \$114 million. Exports were \$31 million and imports were \$123 million. The import penetration represented 60 per cent of the domestic market. The domestic market for portable compressors and parts is estimated at 20 per cent, while stationary air and gas compressors and parts accounted for 80 per cent. The only statistics available for 1985 were imports, which increased to \$152 million and exports which totalled \$24.1 million. In 1986, exports were \$11.7 million, a decline of 51 per cent, while imports decreased to \$14 4 million. The international marketplace for all types of compressors and compressor sets is dominated by a few large manufacturers who have all the inherent benefits and economies of scale. However, the high level of imports clearly indicates opportunities for Canadian manufacture. There is a potential manufacturing opportunity for domestic and commercial portable compressors for fueling motor vehicles. Small compressors for oil and gas field service may also have manufacturing potential. Many Canadian companies have the manufacturing capability to expand or enter the compressor product area, particularly through such vehicles as joint ventures or licensing agreements with foreign manufacturers.
