CANADIAN MARKET OPPORTUNITIES - IMPORT PROFILE PARTS AND ACCESSORIES FOR AIR AND GAS COMPRESSORS

INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

This report is one of a continuing series designed to increase business awareness of the potential existing for domestic production and to stimulate Canadian business to further explore potential opportunities in both the Canadian and export markets. It is important to emphasize that this report does not attempt any assessment as to the feasibility of manufacturing or competing in a particular market and should be treated as an indicator or starting point for the manufacturer or entrepreneur.

Parts and accessories for air and gas compressors, as covered in this report, are classified to Import Commodity Classification (M.C.C.) Code 507-36. This code is subdivided into the following eight Canadian International Trade Classification (C.I.T.C.) Codes. This report consists of the eight classes of products combined, as well as individual data on each product. Compressors are usually sold as a complete compression set, system or package which is comprised of a compressor, a driver and all the required components such as structural base, lubrication system, cooling system, silencing, air intakes, controls, etc., necessary to produce a functioning machine. This import class includes only parts and accessories for the compressors. Parts and accessories included in this profile are used in industries such as construction, manufacturing, the oil and gas field industry, etc. Data for stationary type and portable, air and gas compressors are included in profile numbers 84-87 and 85-87.



IMPORT TRENDS: OVERVIEW

PARTS AND ACCESSORIES FOR AIR AND GAS COMPRESSORS (507-36)



The value of imports decreased significantly from \$93.4 million in 1982 to \$55.4 million in 1983. However, it has increased to \$65.2 million in 1984, and to \$78.3 million in 1985.

During the first nine months of 1986, the value of imports declined by nine per cent, when compared to the same period of 1985. For that period of 1986, imports amounted to \$53.6 million.

In analysing this data, it should be noted that individual categories of products within the group are broad, including individual products of small value, as well as high value. As a result, aggregate data shows large fluctuations from year to year and from one category to another. Nevertheless the data, as presented, gives an overview of the sector while showing areas for potentially more detailed examination.

During the entire period, the United States dominated the Canadian import market for parts and accessories for air and gas compressors. Its exports represented at least 85 per cent of Canadian imports for each of the four years. In 1985, the U.S.A. accounted for \$68 million, or 87 per cent of Canadian imports. The United Kingdom was second, supplying five per cent of the import market.



Parts and accessories for compressors are divided into two major categories, air and gas. Air can be further subdivided into a) stationary air; and b) portable air. Gas is subdivided into a) stationary gas; and b) gas compressors, not elsewhere specified.

From 1982 and 1985, the value of imports of parts and accessories for air and gas compressors decreased at an average annual rate of six per cent. In 1985, parts and accessories for all types of gas compressor parts totalled \$48.2 million or 62 per cent of the total imports. Stationary air compressor parts accounted for \$25.5 million or 33 per cent of the total imports. In 1985, the United States was the principal exporter to Canada of all types of parts and accessories for air and gas compressors.

IMPORTS BY PROVINCE OF CLEARANCE - 1985

In 1985, the bulk of the imports of parts and accessories for air and gas compressors were cleared through three provinces. Alberta was the major province of clearance with \$30.4 million, or 39 per cent of the imports of parts and accessories for air and gas compressors. Ontario was a close second province of clearance with \$29.6 million or 38 per cent of the imports. Québec was third with \$11.7 million, or 15 per cent of the imports. The remaining imports, \$6.6 million or eight per cent, were cleared through the other provinces. In 1985, the 10 major importers of parts and accessories for air and gas compressors accounted for \$48.2 million, or 62 per cent of the value of imports. Four of the ten major importers were manufacturers of air and gas compressors, mining machinery and equipment, or turbines and turbine generator sets accounting for \$35.0 million of imports. The other six major importers, were wholesalers of industrial, construction and mining machinery and equipment, and they accounted for \$13.2 million of imports. Of the top 10 importers, four companies were located in Alberta, three in Ontario and three in Québec.

NOTE: "Top importers" are the known importers with the largest imports by value in 1985.

In 1985, there were at least 663 importers of parts and accessories for air and gas compressors. The top 30 importers accounted for \$58.9 million, or 75 per cent of the value of imports. Nineteen of the top 30 importers were manufacturers, who represented \$43.0 million or 55 per cent of the value of imports. Twelve of these nineteen importers were manufacturers of non-electrical machinery, and accounted for \$39.4 million of imports of parts and accessories for air and gas compressors. Eleven of the top 30 importers were wholesalers; nine of these eleven importers were wholesalers of durable goods, which accounted for \$14.4 million of the imports.

UNITED STATES' IMPORTS

The United States Department of Commerce indicates U.S. imports of all stationary and portable compressors and parts from all countries totalled C\$353.5 million in 1985. Parts of compressors accounted for \$209.8 million. Canada's share of total U.S. imports of parts of compressors totalled at least \$24 million. For further details see Appendix B, page 13.

CANADIAN PRODUCTION

There are approximately four manufacturers of parts and accessories for air and gas compressors in Canada. Statistics Canada reports that shipments of parts for air and gas compressors totalled \$6.1 million, in 1984 (the latest year for which information is available).

CANADIAN EXPORTS

In 1986, Statistics Canada reported that exports of stationary and portable compressors accounted for 2 466 units valued at \$3.6 million. Air compressors accounted for 2 418 units, valued at \$2.2 million; gas compressors accounted for 48 units valued at \$1.4 million. Parts for the stationary and portable compressors totalled \$8.1 million in 1986. This does not include all compressors as other types are included in export codes that do not show separate data for compressors (e.g. 655-99 Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Equipment and Parts, Not Elsewhere Specified).

DEPARTMENT OF SUPPLY AND SERVICES PROCUREMENTS

The Department of Supply and Services reports that the federal government purchased \$5.2 million worth of stationary and portable compressors during the period April 1985 to March 1986. This value includes acquisitions, repair and maintenance.

NOTE: This figure is for purchases by the Department of Supply and Services only, and may not include direct purchases by other federal government departments.

MARKET SUMMARY

This profile deals specifically with parts and accessories for air and gas compressors. Data for stationary air and gas compressors and portable compressors are included in profile numbers 84-87 and 85-87. The range of products covered in these three profiles includes standard plant air compressors, engine driven portables, oil and gas field production, process and pipeline service compressors and sets. Also included are a wide range of miscellaneous compressors and sets for such diverse end uses as artists' air brushes, scuba diving, etc.

In 1984, the domestic market for all types of compressors and parts was estimated at \$206 million, with domestic shipments of \$114 million. Exports were \$31 million and imports were \$123 million. The import penetration represents 60 per cent of the domestic market. The domestic market for stationary air and gas compressors, and parts is estimated at 80 per cent, while portable compressor and parts account for 20 per cent. The only statistics available for 1985, were imports, which increased to \$152 million and exports which totalled \$24.1 million. In 1986, exports were \$11.7 million a decline of 51 per cent while imports decreased to \$144 million. The international marketplace for all types of compressors and compressors sets is dominated by a few large manufacturers who have all the inherent benefits and economies of scale. However, the high level of imports clearly indicates opportunities for Canadian manufacture.
