INTRODUCTION

This report is part of a continuing series designed to increase business awareness of the potential existing for production in Canada.

CANADIAN PRODUCTION

There are at least 55 known suppliers (including manufacturers) of venetian shades and blinds in Canada. Statistics Canada reports that shipments of all types of venetian blinds amounted to \$54.9 million in 1984, the latest year for which information is available.

CANADIAN EXPORTS

Statistics Canada does not publish separate data on the export of venetian shades and blinds. They are included in the export commodity code entitled furniture and fixtures, not elsewhere specified. Canadian exports are minimal.

MARKET SUMMARY

The Canadian Curtains and Drapes Sector

The Canadian curtains and drapes sector comprises manufacturers of textile curtains, drapes, blinds and window-coverings. While separate data for venetian shades and blinds are not available, it is estimated that blinds currently represent about 55 per cent of sector production. In 1986, based on major manufacturing activity, it is estimated that the curtains and drapes sector consisted of some 26 establishments, provided employment to approximately 1 750 workers and reported shipments of \$91.9 million, all of which were made to customers within Canada.


The apparent Canadian market for textile curtains and drapes, including venetian, edged up 1.7 per cent from \$102.6 million in 1985 to \$104.4 million in 1986; in 1984 to 1985, it had increased 3 per cent. Both domestic shipments of own manufacture and imports contributed to the overall increase in 1986 from the previous year.

Thus, domestic shipments of own manufacture registered a small increase of 1.4 per cent between the two years rising up to \$91.9 million in 1986 from \$90.6 million in the previous year. In 1984 to 1985, they had risen 2.7 per cent. Domestic shipments of own manufacture accounted for 88 per cent of the apparent market (88.2 per cent in 1985). This high market share suggests that Canadian producers are continuing to dominate this textile product sector.

Imports of textile curtains and drapes etc., rose 4 per cent from \$12.1 million in 1985 to \$12.5 million in 1986, accounting for 11.9 per cent of the apparent market (11.2 per cent in 1985). Developed countries accounted for the bulk of these imports (87 per cent) with the main suppliers being the United States (66.4 per cent), Japan (5 per cent), Switzerland (4 per cent), Italy (4 per cent), the United Kingdom (2.4 %) and France (2.1 per cent). Low-wage countries supplied a low 13 per cent led by Taiwan (10.5 per cent).
