EXPLANATORY NOTES

Method

The data shown in this analysis are extracted from Revenue Canada Customs documents. These documents provide a description of the products, names of importers, exporters, quantities, dollar values, unit prices, countries of origin, provinces of entry, tariff applications and rates of exchange.

The information presented in this report is more detailed than that generally available from Statistics Canada or other publications. Data which might reveal information about individual importers are aggregated.

Valuation

Dollar values shown in this report are based on selling price F.O.B. plant, in Canadian dollars. This selling price represents the value paid by the importer, excluding all freight, packing and insurance costs when specified. All trade discounts, when applicable, are also deducted from the selling price.

IMPORT ANALYSIS

VINYL COATED POLYESTER FABRICS (FOR GARDEN FURNITURE)

I. INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

This Import Analysis is one of a series prepared in order to assist businesses and other organizations in their market research of specific products. The detailed import information provided in these reports supports studies by organizations seeking to expand existing production lines, change individual product characteristics or engage in new manufacturing investment in Canada. The coverage of an import analysis is developed in close consultation with the client, and is tailored to meet those specific requirements. It is important to emphasize that this report does not attempt any assessment as to the feasibility of competing in a particular market.

This analysis of imports of vinyl coated <u>polyester</u> fabrics used exclusively for the manufacture of garden furniture is based on a detailed examination of Revenue Canada Customs imports documents for the period October to December 1987. The following Canadian International Trade Classification (C.I.T.C.) import commodity code was analysed:

387-09-89 Vinyl Coated Fabric, Man-made Fiber and Blends, Not Elsewhere Specified

The above mentioned C.I.T.C. code includes vinyl coated fabrics for uses other than for the manufacture of garden furniture. Total imports of <u>all</u> fabrics for this code, for the period of analysis (October, November and December, 1987) amounted to \$5.3 million. Of this total, \$1.5 million or 28 per cent was described as vinyl coated <u>polyester</u> fabric for the use in the manufacture of garden furniture, as reported in this analysis.

II. IMPORT TRENDS

Vinyl coated <u>polyester</u> fabrics used exclusively for the manufacture of garden furniture were normally imported into Canada under a specific Canada Customs Tariff item namely 57406-01. Total imports into Canada under this tariff item increased 7 per cent in terms of value from 1986 to 1987. Complete yearly statistics for Tariff item 57406-01, prior to 1986, are not available. For a detailed description and rates of duty, see Appendix F.

III. ANALYSIS OF IMPORTS

During the months of October, November and December 1987, imports of vinyl coated polyester fabrics for garden furniture, as analysed in this report, totalled 612 000 square meters for a value of \$1.5 million.


Vinyl coated polyester fabrics used in the manufacture of garden furniture ranged from \$4.27 to \$6.41 per kilogram. (For further details, refer to Appendix A.)

All imports originated from the United States.

Québec was the major province to which imports of vinyl coated polyester fabrics for garden furniture were consigned, accounting for \$973 000 or 65 per cent of the total dollar value. Ontario accounted for the remaining \$522 000 or 35 per cent. (For further details, refer to Appendix B.)



IMPORT MARKET CONCENTRATION OCTOBER, NOVEMBER AND DECEMBER 1987

There were 19 known consignees/importers of vinyl coated polyester fabrics for garden furniture during the months October, November and December 1987. The principal three consignees/importers accounted for \$639 000 or 43 per cent of the total value of imports. All consignees/importers are listed in alphabetical order in Appendix C.
