
SCOPE OF ANALYSIS


This report is based on a detailed examination of documents covering imports of drain and sewage cleaners for the period January to December 1983 included in Statistics Canada Import Commodity Code: 730-99-54 "Sewer Cleaning units, Sewage Treatment Equipment."

Excluded from this analysis are cleaning equipment and parts such as augers, blades, cables, cutters, hand spinners, hoses, etc.

During the years 1980 to 1984, the value of imports decreased at an average annual rate of minus 6.30 per cent. The peak was in 1982 at 2.1 million (see Figure I - page 4).







SECTION II

RECONCILIATION

The value reported in this analysis does not correspond to official Statistics Canada figures for various reasons.

SECTION III

ANALYSIS OF IMPORTS

Imports of drain and sewage cleaners during the period January to December 1983 totalled 431 units valued at \$1,018,201.

Ninety-three per cent of the total quantity represents cleaners with a value of less than \$3,000. The cleaners in the high-price imports group are probably high-pressure water-blast/ vacuum type catch basin sewer cleaners, rodding or bucket-type sewer cleaners used for cleaning town and city sewage systems.

All imports originated from the United States; and 55 per cent of imports by value entered Western Canadian ports (see Figure II - page 8).

Of the \$1.0 million of imports, the top three importers accounted for 40 per cent, the top five 57 per cent and the top ten 76 per cent. During the period covered in this report, exchange rates for the U.S. dollar varied from \$1.22 to \$1.25.

Full details of the analysis are provided in the following table.

NOTE: Dollar values shown are based on selling price F.O.B. plant, in Canadian dollars. This selling price represents the value paid by the importer, excluding all freight, packing and insurance costs when specified. All trade discounts when applicable are also deducted from the selling price.


