SECTION I

SCOPE OF ANALYSIS

This report on residential, industrial and commercial electronic air cleaners is based on a detailed examination of Revenue Canada Customs and Excise import documents. The period covered is the calendar year 1983. These products are classified to Canadian International Trade Classification (C.I.T.C.) Import Commodity Code 655-99-40: Cleaners, air, electrostatic (a category that also contains filters and parts). "Ecologizers" are not included in this report.

SECTION II

ANALYSIS OF IMPORTS

Imports of electronic air cleaners for the period analyzed totalled 13,053 units valued at \$1,511,007.


The analysis shows that identified residential-type air cleaners accounted for 56 per cent or \$845,467 of the total value.

Imports from the United States comprise 86 per cent of the total value reported in this study, and the remaining 14 per cent originated from Japan.

Of every dollar of imports on which this analysis is based, 62 cents entered at ports in the province of Ontario, 21 cents at ports east of Ontario, and 17 cents at ports in the Western Provinces.

B) CATEGORY AND VALUE


