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#### SECTION I - INTRODUCTION

#### Scope of Analysis

This analysis of imports of compact disc players is based on a detailed examination of Revenue Canada, Customs and Excise import documents for the period January 1984 to June 1985. Compact disc players are classified to Canadian International Trade Classification import commodity code 637-59-10 "Phonographs, Domestic Type."

#### Method

The data shown in this analysis were extracted from Revenue Canada Customs documents. These documents provide a description of the products, names of importers, exporters, quantities, dollar values, unit prices, countries of origin, provinces of entry, tariff applications and rates of exchange.

Please note that dollar values shown are based on selling price F.O.B. plant, in Canadian dollars. This selling price represents the value paid by the importer, excluding all freight, packing and insurance costs when specified. All trade discounts when applicable are also deducted from the selling price.

## SECTION II - ANALYSIS AND OBSERVATIONS

## Analysis of Imports

Imports of compact disc players as reported on documents examined for the period January 1984 to June 1985, totaled 17,343 units valued at \$5,262,753.

The table below indicates that shifts in proportion of imports from the higher priced ranges (\$200-\$400) to the lower priced ranges (\$151-\$320) have occured, which can be attributed to the overall price decrease of CD Players.





#### FIG.1 - COUNTRY OF ORIGIN


Of the total import market value, shipments originating from Japan accounted 70 per cent followed by Belgium with 12 per cent and Netherlands with 11 per cent. remaining countries descending order of value were United Kingdom, United States. Switzerland, West Germany Their values Denmark. were aggregated for reasons of confidentiality.
