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IMPORT ANALYSIS

POLYPROPYLENE PLASTIC STRAPPING

I. INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

This Import Analysis is one of a series prepared in order to assist businesses and other organizations in their market research of specific products. The detailed import information provided in these reports supports studies by organizations seeking to expand existing production lines, change individual product characteristics or engage in new manufacturing investment in Canada. The coverage of an import analysis is developed in close consultation with the client, and is tailored to meet those specific requirements. It is important to emphasize that this report does not attempt any assessment as to the feasibility of competing in a particular market.


This analysis of imports of polypropylene plastic strapping is based on a detailed examination of Revenue Canada Customs import documents for the period January to December 1986. This strapping is a shippers fastening device used to band cartons, crates and skids of material. The following Canadian International Trade Classification (C.I.T.C.) import commodity code was analysed:

425-99-25 Strapping, Plastic, Polypropylene.

Total figures in this report do not correspond to those published by Statistics Canada. The differences are explained in Appendix F.

II. ANALYSIS OF IMPORTS IMPORT TRENDS 1982-1986 (Thousands of Dollars)

Between 1982 and 1986 the value of polypropylene plastic strapping increased from \$3 million to \$4.9 million (an average annual growth rate of 12.9 per cent), despite a decrease of 8 per cent in 1984.

II. ANALYSIS OF IMPORTS (CONT'D)


Imports of polypropylene plastic strapping as reported on import documents for the years 1986 were 4.1 million lbs., with a value of \$4.1 million.

Although unit prices ranged from under \$0.20 to over 9 dollars per pound, over 80 per cent of the imports were in the range of \$0.70 to \$1.29 per pound. See Appendix A for details.


COUNTRY OF ORIGIN

The United States was the dominant source of imports of polypropylene plastic strapping during the period analysed, accounting for \$3.8 million, or 93 per cent of the total import value. Other countries exporting to Canada include the following, in order of value: Federal Republic of Germany, the Netherlands, Taiwan and Japan. A detailed list of major foreign exporters to Canada is shown in Appendix C.

Imports valued at \$3.4 million or 84 per cent of the total value, were to consignees in Ontario. Québec was the second province with \$663 thousand, or 16 per cent. The remaining \$2 776, or less than 1 per cent was to consignees in other provinces.
