IMPORT ANALYSIS

WELDING HELMETS AND WELDING FACE SHIELDS

I. INTRODUCTION AND SCOPE

This Import Analysis is one of a series prepared in order to assist businesses and other organizations in their market research of specific products. The detailed import information provided in these reports supports studies by organizations seeking to expand existing production lines, change individual product characteristics or engage in new manufacturing investment in Canada. The coverage of an import analysis is developed in close consultation with the client, and is tailored to meet those specific requirements. It is important to emphasize that this report does not attempt any assessment as to the feasibility of competing in a particular market.

This analysis of imports of welding helmets and welding face shields is based on a detailed examination of Revenue Canada Customs imports documents for the period January to June 1987. The following Canadian International Trade Classification (C.I.T.C.) import commodity codes were analysed:

II. ANALYSIS OF IMPORTS

During the months of January to June 1987, imports of welding helmets and welding face shields as analysed in this report totalled 31.9 thousand units for a value of \$490 000. Welding helmets accounted for most of these imports: 31 thousand units for \$480 000.



Welding helmets in the price range of \$10.00 to \$19.99 accounted for 24 000 units or \$368 000, (77 per cent of the total value and quantity of imports). Welding face shields were imported in the price range of \$6.00 to \$85.00 accounting for 862 units for a value of \$10 000. For further details, refer to Appendix A.

The United States was the dominant source of imports for welding helmets and welding face shields, accounting for \$484 000 or 99 per cent of the total dollar value. Taiwan, Sweden and Japan accounted for the remaining imports (1 per cent).

PROVINCE OF CONSIGNEE



Ontario was the major province of consignee for the imports analysed. It accounted for \$457 000 or 93 per cent of the value of imports, followed by Alberta with \$13 000 or 3 per cent. The provinces of Saskatchewan, British Columbia and Québec accounted for the remaining imports.

There were 23 known consignees/importers of welding helmets and welding face shields during the period January to June 1987. The principal 10 consignees/importers accounted for \$459 000 or 94 per cent of the total dollar value of imports. All consignees/importers are listed in alphabetical order in Appendix B.

At the present time, welding helmets and welding face shields are not manufactured in Canada.
